Noun

A noun is the name of a person, place, animal or thing.

For example:- Deepak, Jyoti, Dog, Chair, etc.

➤ **There are four kinds of noun**

- 1. Common noun**
- 2. Proper noun**
- 3. Countable noun**
- 4. Uncountable noun**

- 1. Common Noun:- Common noun are general names that we are used for a person, place or things.**

For example:- School, Shop, Boy, Girl, Uncle, etc

- 2. Proper Noun:- Proper noun is the name of a particular person, place, organization or thing.**

For example:- Jatin, Amar bal school, English book, etc.

- 3. Countable Noun:- Countable noun are those things which we can count using numbers.**

For example:- few books, students, subjects, etc.

- 4. Uncountable noun:- Uncountable noun are those things that we cannot count using numbers**

For example:- hair, happiness, rice, stars, etc.
