## PILOT PROJECTS

The heart of an experimental program consists of the pilot activities which make up the raw data for evaluation and model building for later incorporation as part of the curriculum structure. Team teaching, non-graded individualized instruction, language skill acquisition through typing, French/English, Social Sciences, cross-age tutoring, VTR and micro-teaching techniques, Junior/Senior interns, multi-media approaches and open classroom situations provide a continuous flow of data concerning the process of education. Analysis and evaluation of this rich source of information resulted in an operational curriculum enrichment which attempts to satisfy the perceptual and motivational systems of the variety of individuals of which our schools consists.







## FIELD TRIPS AND DEMONSTRATIONS

An essential part of education takes place outside the classroom. The variety of rich historical sites in the near vicinity of Wisdom High School provide a valuable resource and a worthwhile adjunct to the regular curriculum. The Acadian heritage of Wisdom students is brought to the fore by visiting historical sites in the St. John Valley and neighboring Canada. Learning by doing is emphasized by the diversified experiments and demonstration in which the students are involved.




## EVALUATION


