This year, the senior class decided to create an "Inspiration page" for a teacher who is a source of inspiration and support for many, if not all, students in the senior class.

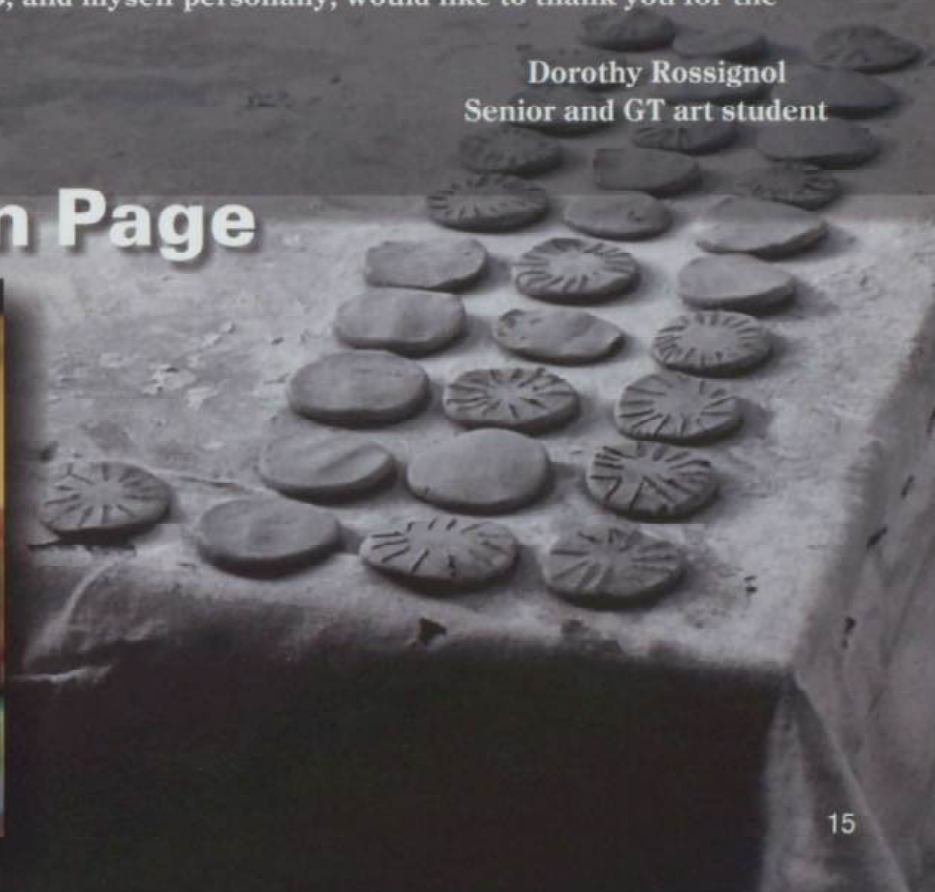

In August of 2006, when this year's senior class was only in third grade, Mrs. Cerceo began teaching in the MSAD 33 school system. Mrs. Cerceo is an energetic and passionate teacher. She made her love for art contagious. She inspires students to be enthusiastic and passionate, not only as a teacher with a love for art, but also as a mentor, supporting students with her empathy and time. Her honest and constructive criticism pushes students to use their imagination and express themselves through art.

To the senior class, especially those in the "Gifted and Talented" art program, Mrs. Cerceo quickly became an anchor in their lives. 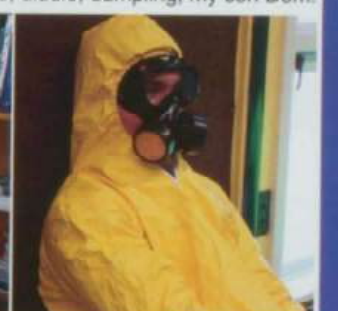


Inside and Outside the Classroom
