Her honest and constructive criticism pushes students to use their imagination and express themselves through art.

To the senior class, especially those in the "Gifted and Talented" art program, Mrs. Cerceo quickly became an anchor in their lives. She is a teacher that has been there from (nearly) the start, following us along on our journey of self-discovery, often lending an ear when necessary, and offering advice when asked. The stories from her experiences that she shares shatters the illusion that teachers are different from any other. She is a humble example of what to do, (and sometimes what not to do). Teaching us to forgive ourselves, to be a tough critic, but never to be cruel to anyone, including yourself. One of her lessons was much like this; "If a man draws a circle, and it is undoubtedly perfect, the only interest it will generate is, 'Well that's nice. It's a circle. Must have been traced.' But, if the circle is imperfect; perhaps a shaky line or a lump where there shouldn't be, people will admire it for longer, wondering who the artist was that put the time to do his best to draw a nearly perfect circle."

Through art, students learn about the beauty of human nature, human form, and the human mind; each a perfectly flawed canvas, which life and experience will paint.

Mrs. Cerceo uses her wisdom of art and expression to teach her students both the importance of color in a work, as well as accepting your faults as part of the canvas that paints the picture of who you are. For this, Mrs. Cerceo, the Class of 2015, and myself personally, would like to thank you for the time, knowledge, and love you invest in us.
