A BIG SPLASH

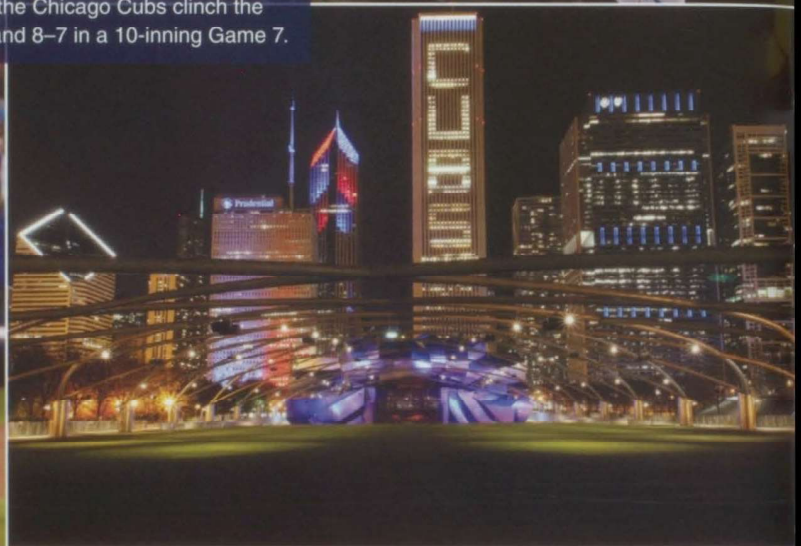
U.S. swimmer, Katie Ledecky, claims four gold medals and one silver in Rio, where she breaks her own world record for the 800-meter freestyle.

For the first time since 1908, the Chicago Cubs clinch the World Series, beating Cleveland 8-7 in a 10-inning Game 7.



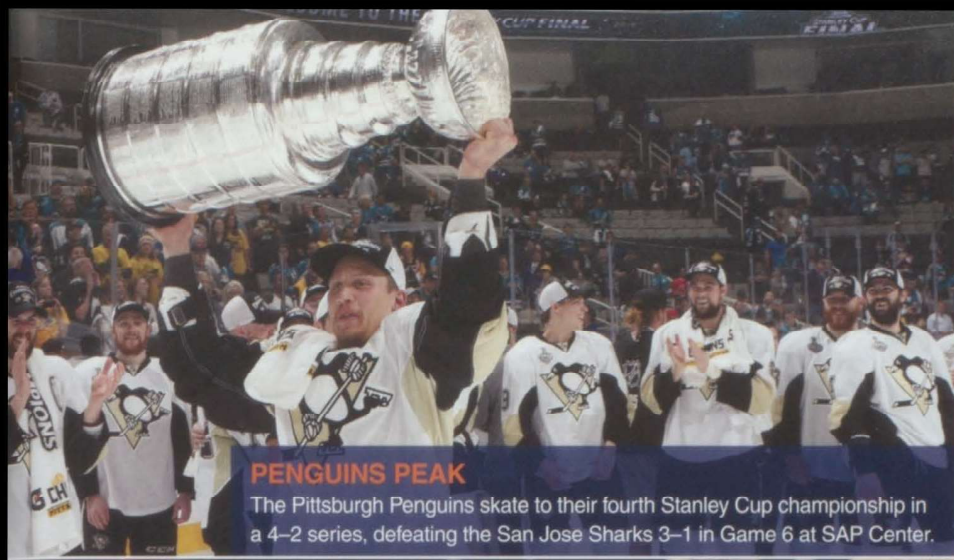

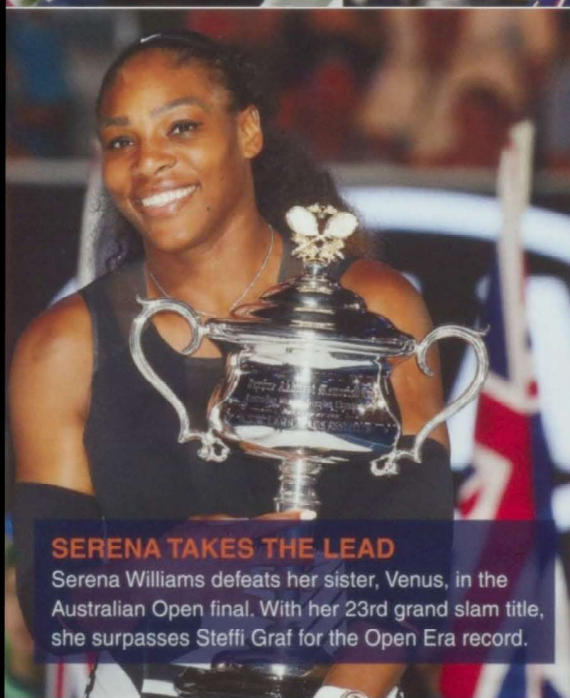
CLEVELAND CLAIMS NBA TITLE

SERENA TAKES THE LEAD

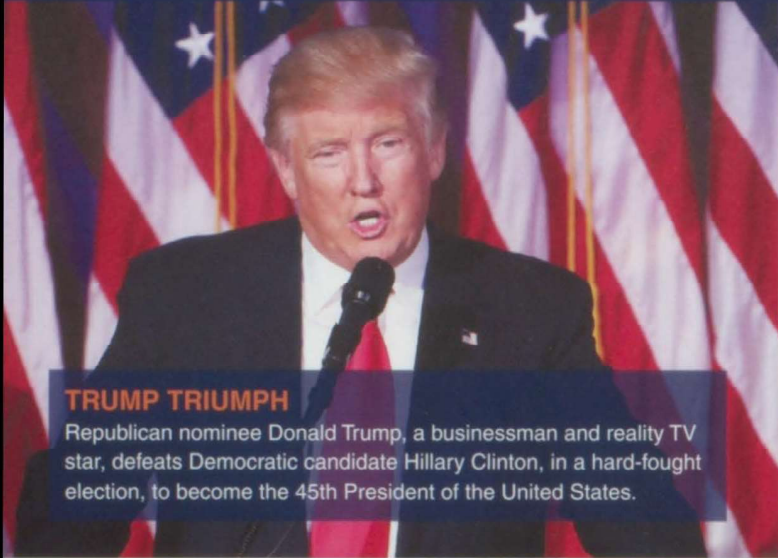
Serena Williams defeats her sister, Venus, in the Australian Open final. With her 23rd grand slam title, she surpasses Steffi Graf for the Open Era record.

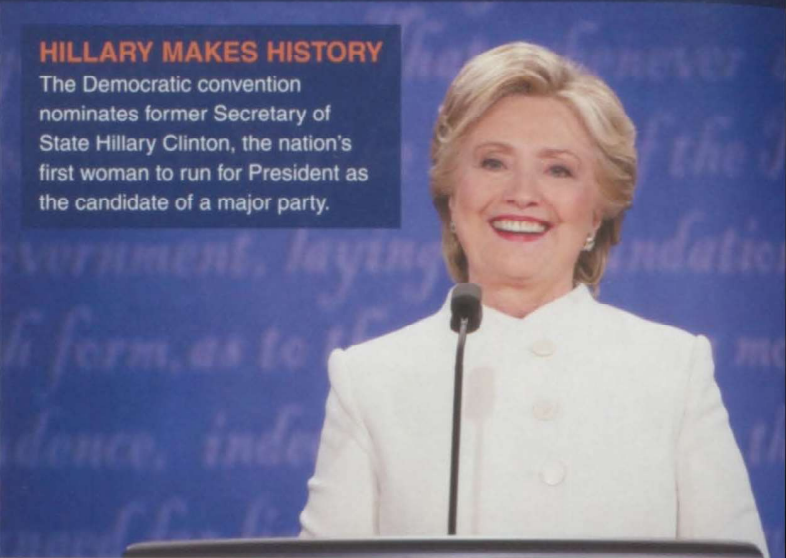


TRUMP TRIUMPH
