In our preliminary game, despite being down by 16 in the 1st quarter, we never gave up. When the horn blew we walked away with a well deserved victory. Though the season didn't end like we felt it was destined to, we learned a lot from our coach and each other. The bond between this "family" is something that can never be broken. It is worth more than words can say.
