Kate White, Naomi Michaud and Tracy Michaud. These three girls are now part of a select group of twenty-four of Maine's best student actors. Congratulations!

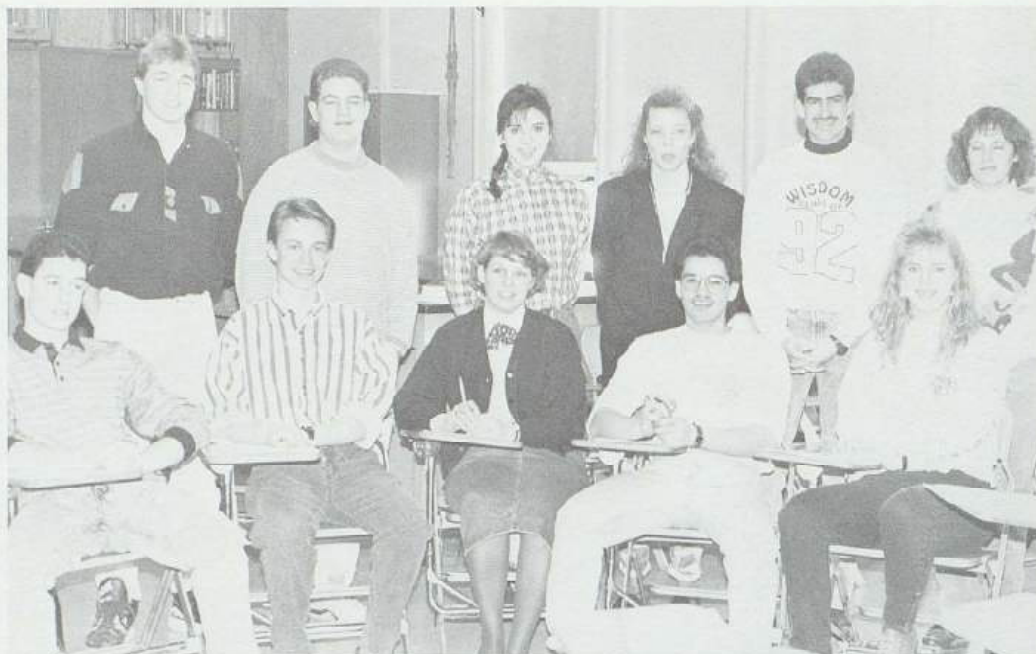

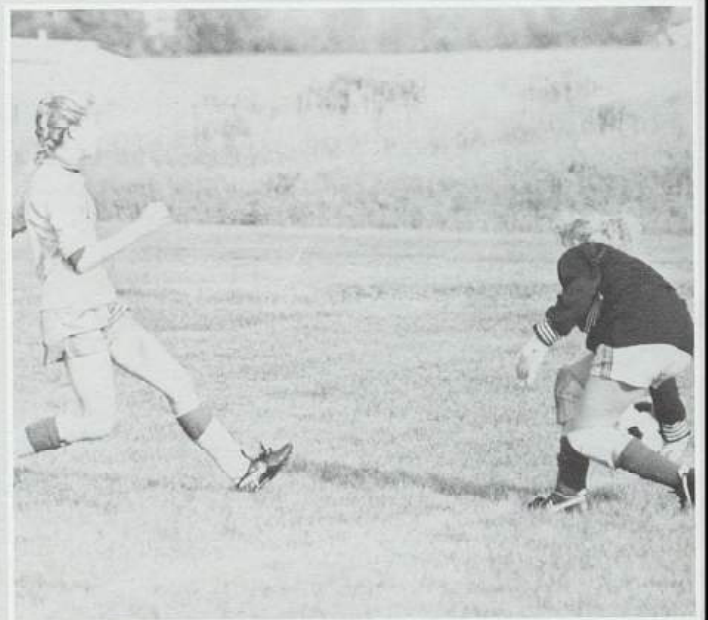
COACH'S CORNER

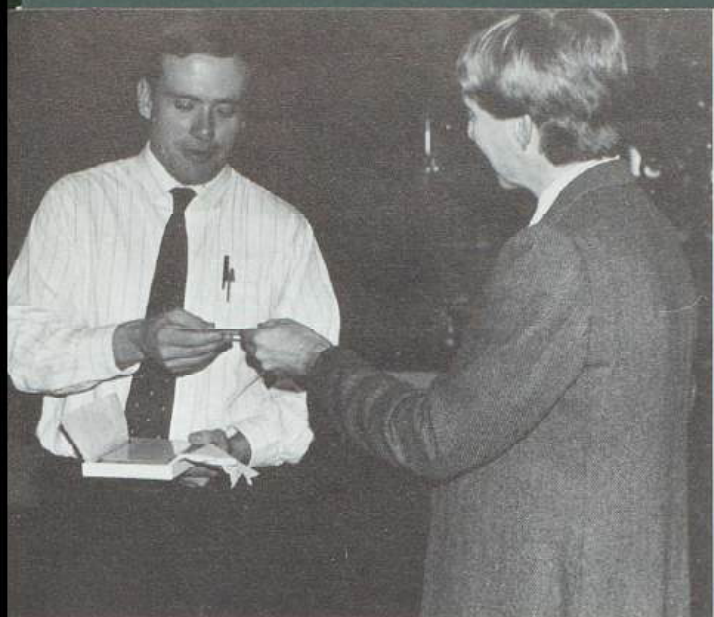
HONOR'S PROGRAM '91
