# Mrs. Lerman

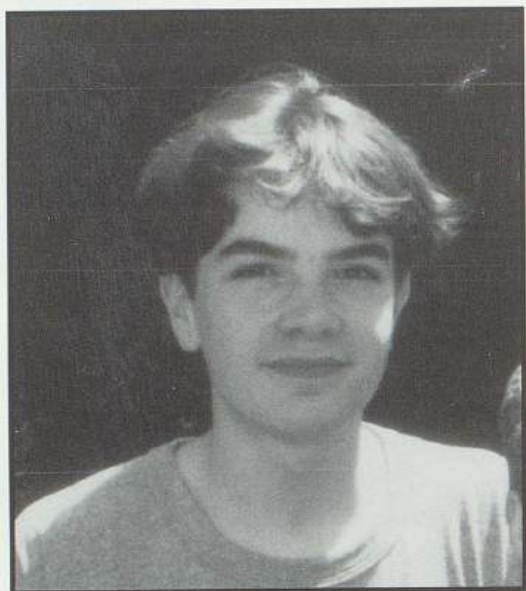
