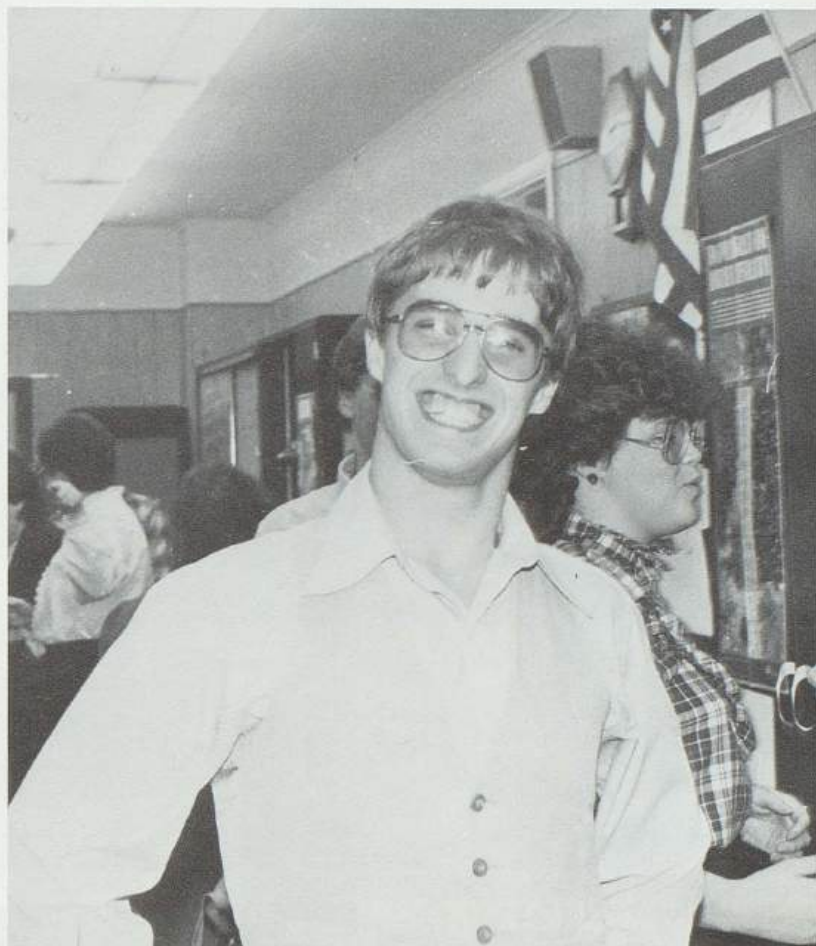




NHS TEA

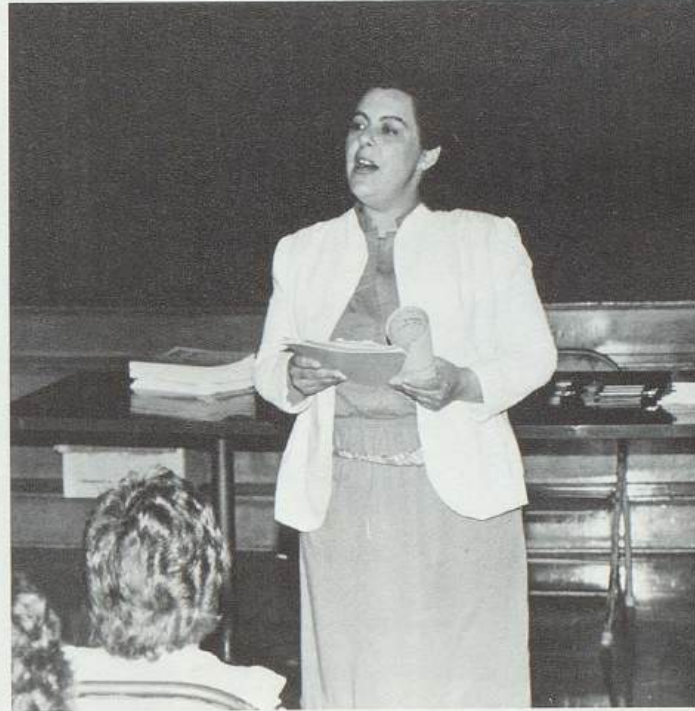
