1986 WISDOM BOY'S AND GIRL'S VOLLEYBALL






















BOY'S VOLLEYBALL SCOREBOARD

"No," she said, "All I see is an old cement slab rounded off by the weather. An old barn use to be there a long time ago."




































WISDOM HIGH COMMENCEMENTS EXERCISES
