"Doubtless there are other roads."





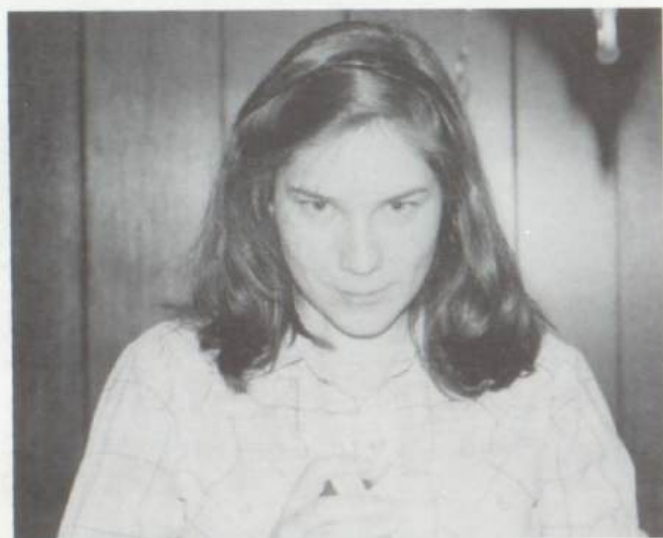

The pages of the story of his life.

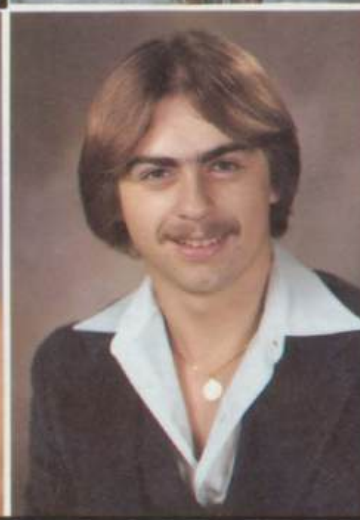
He recalls the strength and virility
