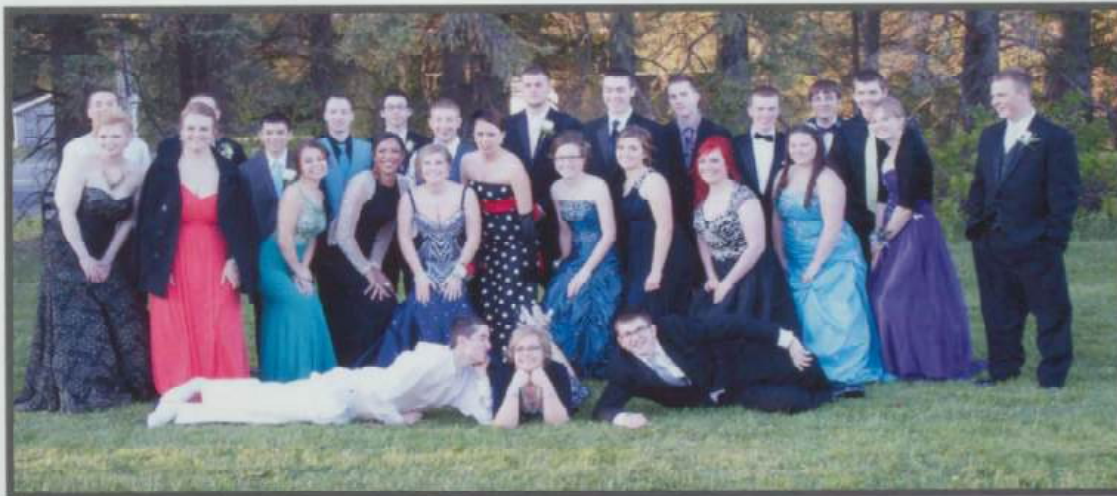


What does teaching mean to me?
