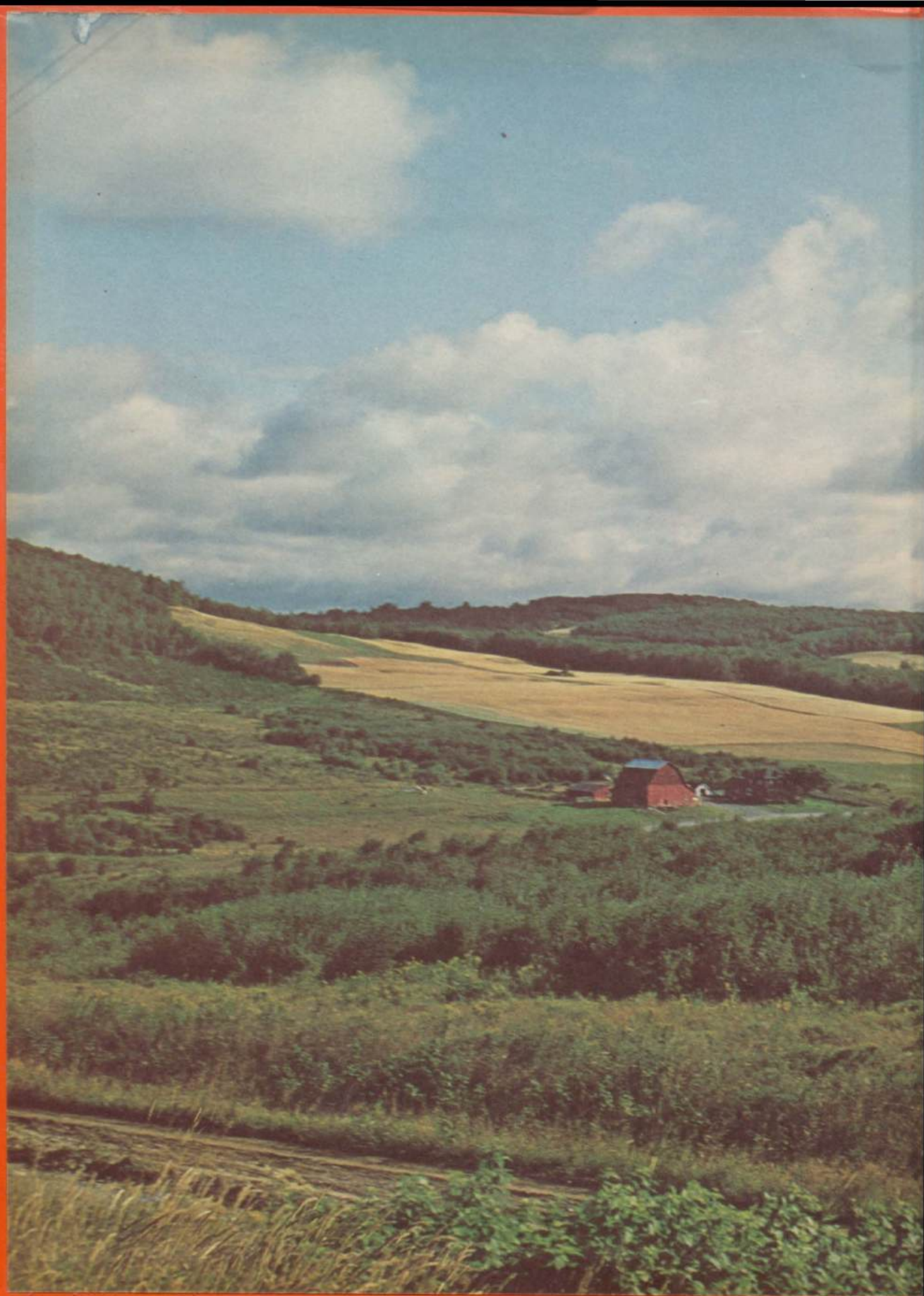


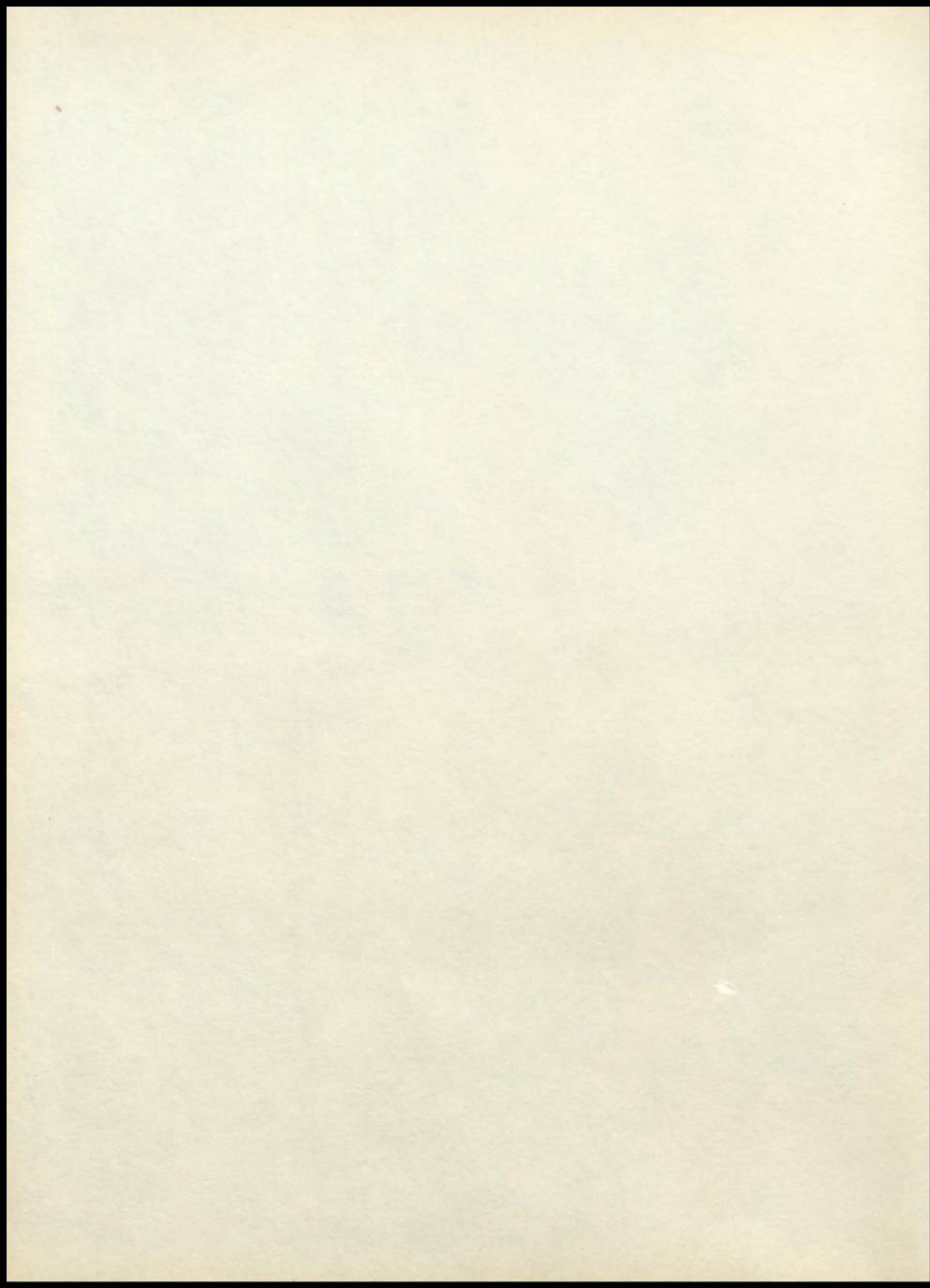

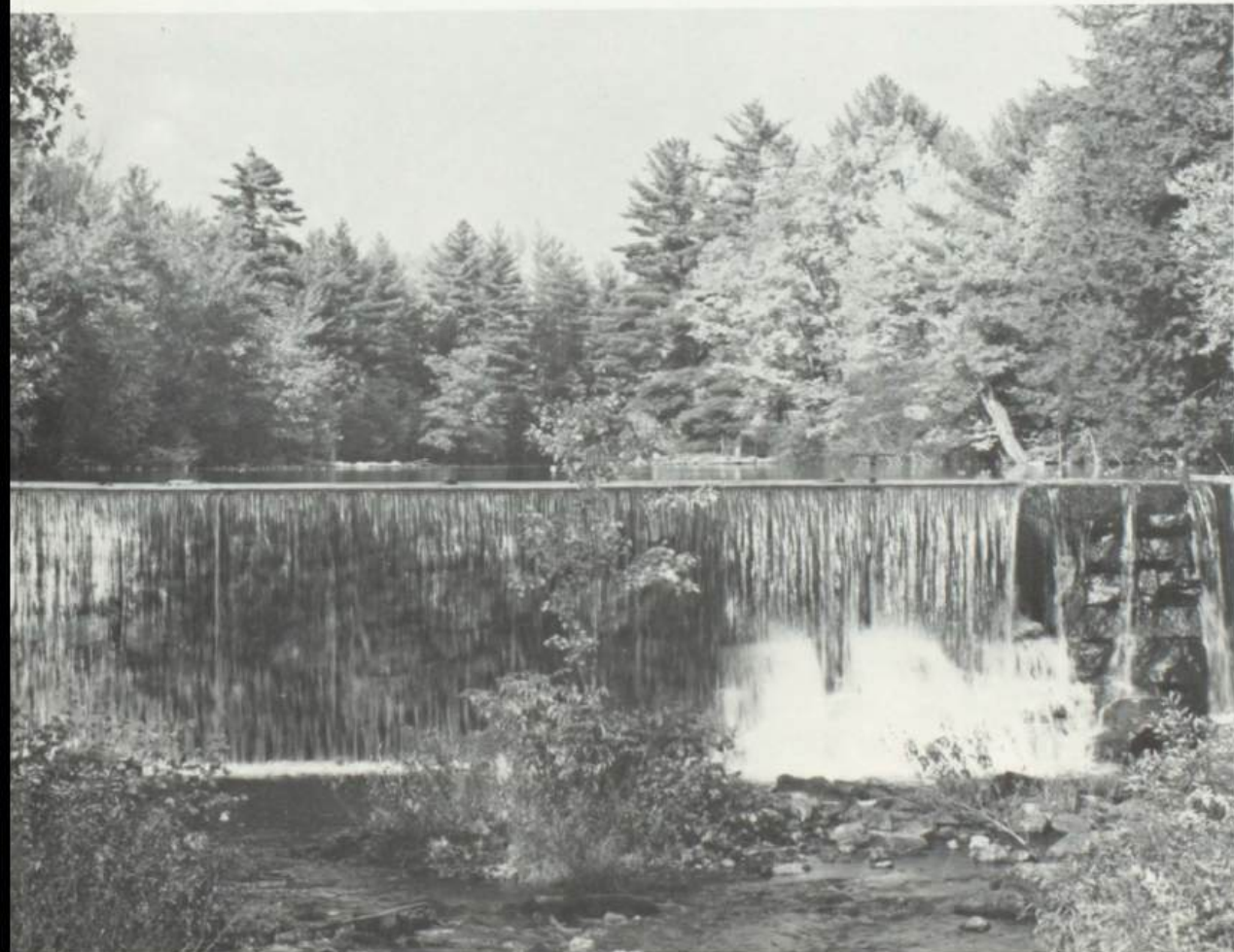




LIFE'S STREAM

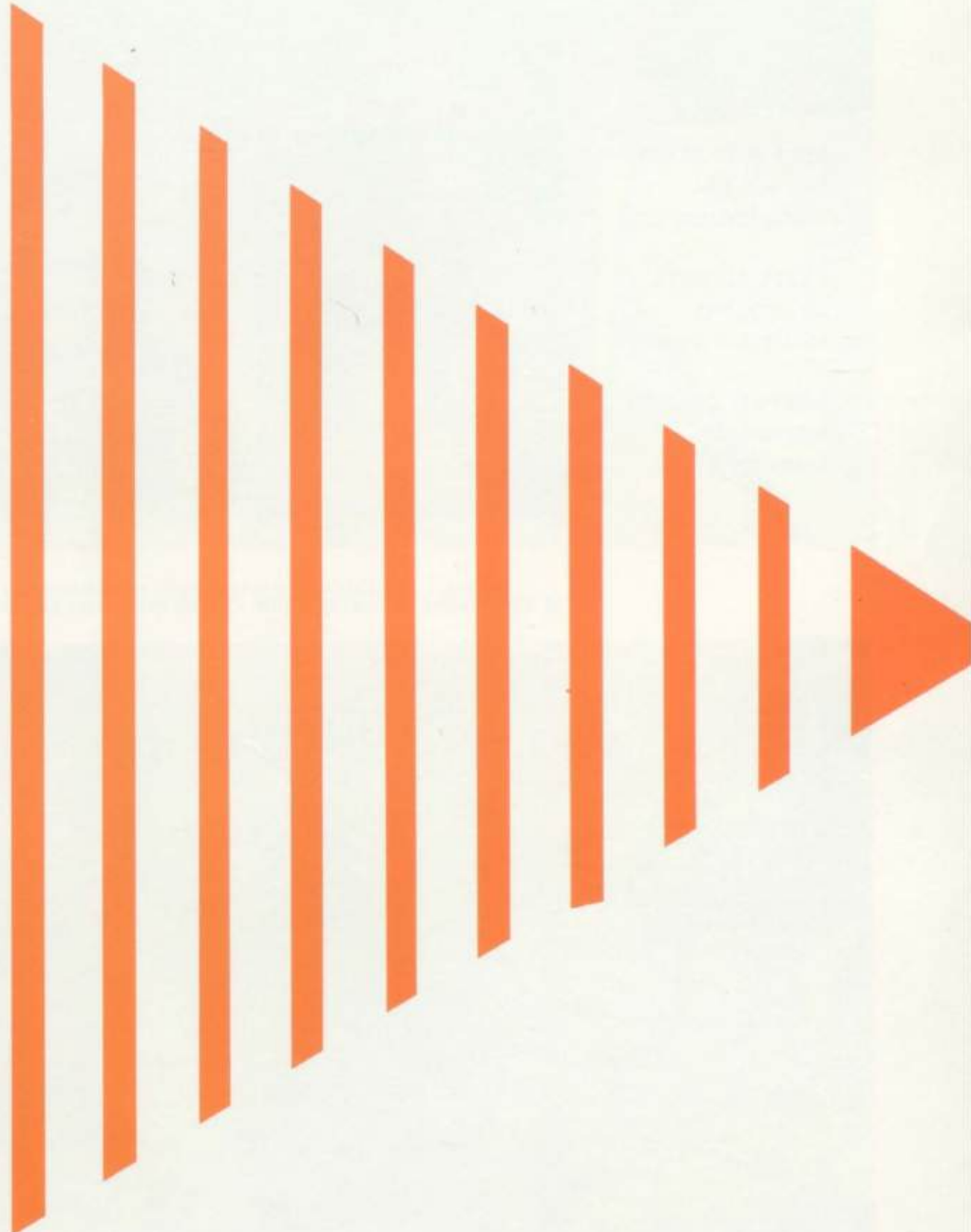
The deep blue summer heavens look glad

Scatters its many charms.

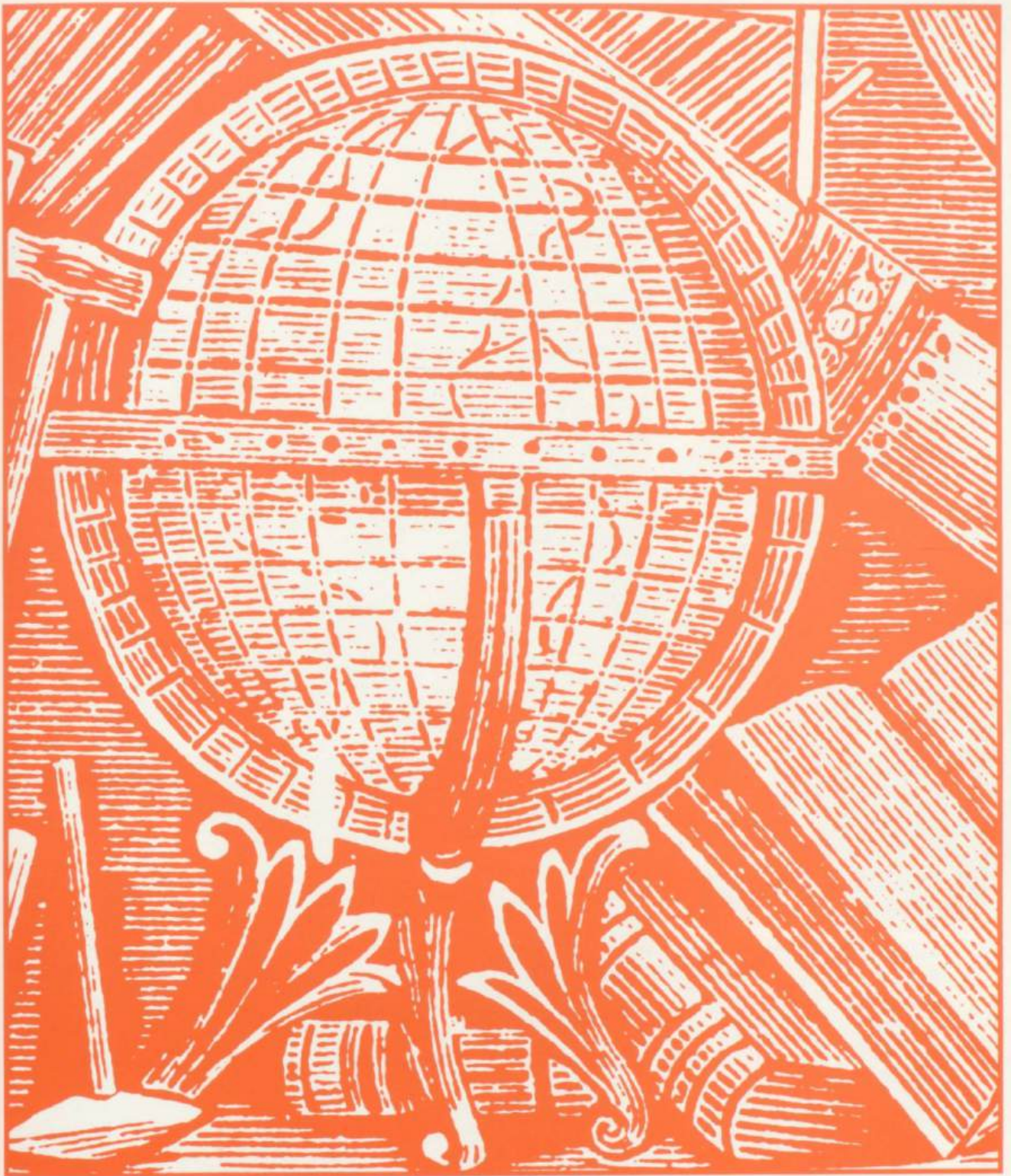
YOUTH

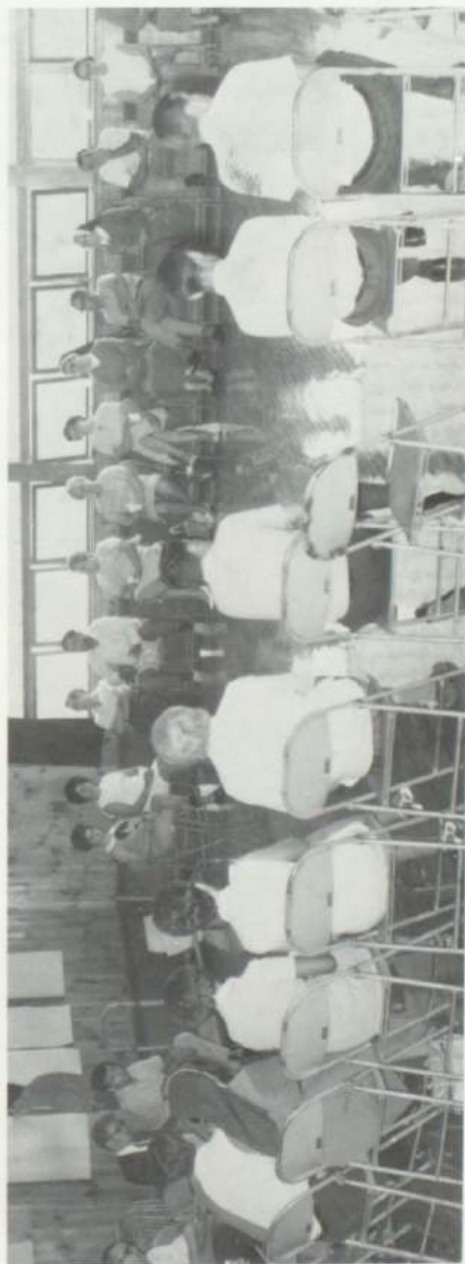

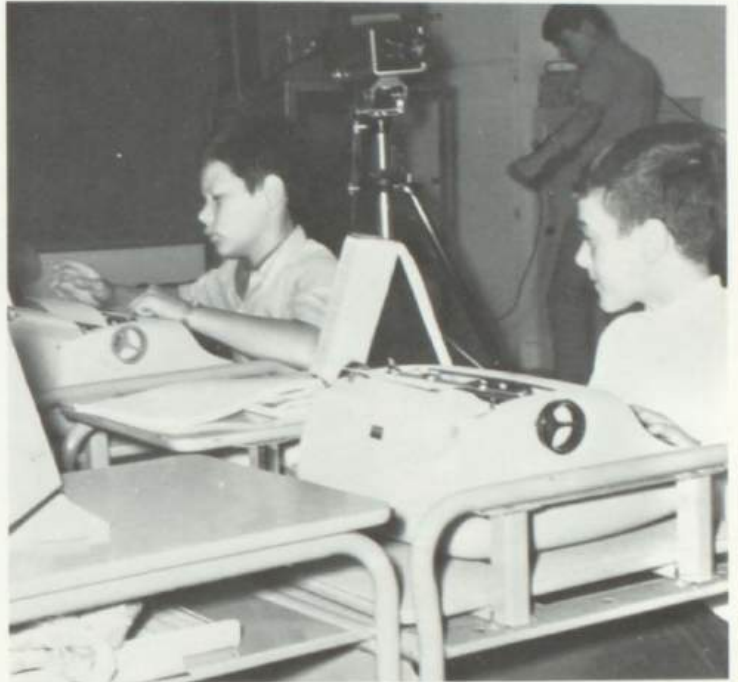
