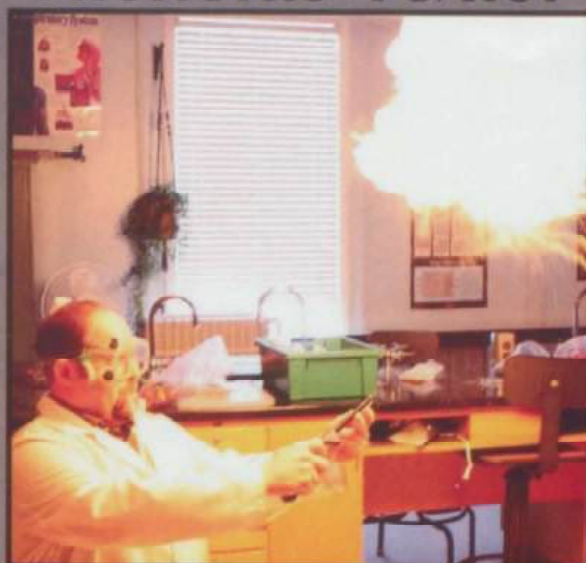




Dedication...
