Tyler Farr will be performing Saturday night, June 28th, at the Butler County Fair! His special guest will be Jess Kellie Adams starting at 7:30.

For those who aren't familiar, Tyler Farr made a big splash in country music with his first album, *Redneck Crazy*, which hit No. 2 on the Billboard Country Albums Chart and No. 5 on the Billboard Top 200. His title track from that album, "Redneck Crazy," went Platinum and really put him on the map. He's also had three No. 1 hits with "Whiskey in My Water" and "A Guy Walks Into a Bar." His second album, *Suffer in Peace*, also did incredibly well, debuting in the Top 5 on both the Billboard Top 200 and Country Albums charts, making him the only solo male country artist in the last ten years to have his first two studio albums debut in the Top 5 on the Billboard 200! He's toured with some of the biggest names

in country music, like Jason Aldean, Florida Georgia Line, Luke Combs, Brantley Gilbert, and Lee Brice. Beyond his music, Tyler is known for his strong support of the military and his love for the outdoors. As he continues to create music that resonates with fans, Tyler Farr remains a formidable force in country music.

Jess Kellie Adams is an exciting emerging country artist based in Nashville. Jess has a strong voice and a sound that uniquely blends classic country with a rock and roll energy.
