## WELCOME TO THE 2026 BUTLER COUNTY FAIR!

The Fair Board and our many volunteers have been hard at work preparing for another exciting year at the fairgrounds.

The Fred and Wava Maifeld Family Memorial Livestock Building is now entering its third year of use and continues to serve exhibitors and visitors well. This year, electrical upgrades were completed following several power outages during cattle shows. Improvements have also been made to the Swine/Sheep Building, including new exterior boards to replace deteriorating wood and replacement of support poles on the west end of the building. A new sidewalk is being added between the Maifeld Livestock Building and the Show Arena to improve handicap accessibility and make travel around the fairgrounds easier for everyone. Additional improvements are happening in the infield area, including a new announcer's stand and a newly constructed check-in building on the south side of the track. Exhibitors will also notice all-new poultry and rabbit cages at the 2026 fair. The new stackable cages make better use of space while improving functionality.

The Junior Fair Board has been busy as well. They added a picket fence and couch to Tom's Hangout inside the Maifeld Livestock Building, creating a more welcoming gathering space. They also transformed an old ticket booth into a children's playhouse located in a safe area just south of the livestock building.

This year's grandstand lineup promises plenty of excitement:

Additional free fair entertainment includes a BBQ Contest, Foam Parties, and Wolves of the World show.

Neo-Traditional Country music trio, The Castellows, will be performing Friday night, June 26th at the Butler County Fair! The trio bring a literal meaning to the phrase, “family tradition.” The band, comprised of sisters Ellie on lead guitar, Powell on banjo, and Lily with vocals, hail from small rural Georgetown, Georgia, but now call Nashville home.

The Castellows’ sound is traditional, yet modern. The common thread among the trio, other than their DNA, is their masterful three-part harmonies which blend together to create one singular, almost angelic, voice. The Castellows’ craft as songwriters is as robust as their voices, which is evident across the trio’s debut musical releases, *A Little Goes A Long Way* and *Alabama Stone*, featuring song “Girl That Boy”.

The Castellows’ next project, the seven-song *Homecoming* release, arrived May 30, 2025, followed by a headline tour of the same name kicking off in Fall 2025. One year later, the three sisters from a cattle farm in Georgia are still turning heads, landing on multiple 2024 ‘Watch Lists’ including CMT Next Women of Country, CMT ‘Listen Up,’ and Nashville Lifestyles, touting their first major award-nomination for CMT Digital-First Performance of the Year at the 2024 CMT Music Awards, hitting the road in the fall of 2024 with *Little Big Town* and *Sugarland* on the *Take Me Home Tour*, and being named a SiriusXM “Highway Find” artist for *The Highway*.

Join us on June 26th to listen to their unique blend of genres, engaging live performance, and the band’s strong musical chemistry and collaboration!

## WITH JESS KELLIE ADAMS

Jess Kellie Adams is returning to the Butler County Fair and will open for The Castellows on Friday, June 26th. Jess is a Nashville-based Country/Rock artist known for her powerful vocals, magnetic stage presence, and an authentic connection that turns every performance into a shared experience. Blending classic country storytelling with a modern rock edge, Jess delivers what fans have come to call “Grit with Grace” country—music that’s bold, hopeful, and deeply human.

Over the past several years, Jess has become a crowd favorite on the fair and festival circuit, earning repeat bookings and opening for major artists including Martina McBride, Josh Turner, Parmalee, Shenandoah, Craig Morgan, Bret Michaels, Jon Pardi, Jo Dee Messina, and Lainey Wilson, among others. Her resume includes performances at top-tier events such as the Ohio State Fair, Florida State Fair, South Carolina State Fair, Tennessee State Fair, Delaware State Fair, Georgia National Fair, East Texas State Fair, Florida Strawberry Festival, and the National Peanut Festival, as well as appearances at CMA Fest / Fan Fair X.

Whether she’s commanding a festival main stage or singing inches from the front row, Jess Kellie Adams brings authenticity, energy, and heart to every performance—leaving crowds inspired and wanting more.

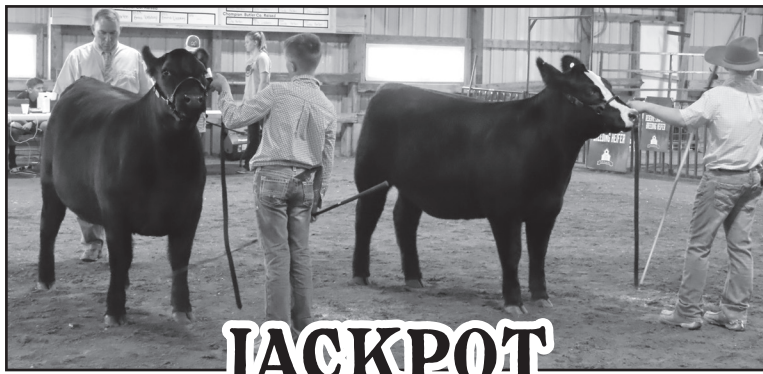

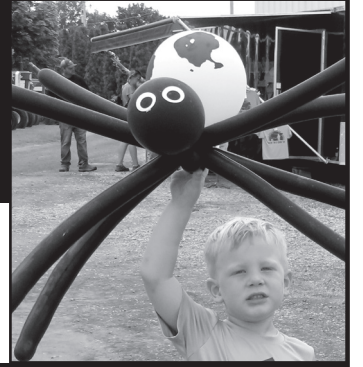

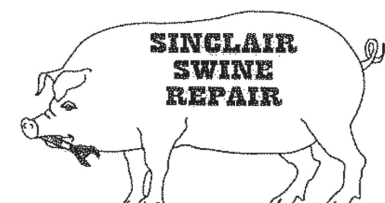
