


Maddie Poppe is a twenty-year-old singer-songwriter from **Clarksville, Iowa**. After performing a duet with her sister at a school variety show in the sixth grade, Maddie fell in love with music and learned to play guitar, ukulele and piano. In 2016, Maddie released her debut album, "Songs From The Basement," which she wrote, produced and recorded alongside her father, Trent. Maddie had been performing locally in Iowa for over five years when she decided to audition for American Idol which she calls her "saving grace." As she continued through the competition, she ultimately stole America's hearts and was crowned the winner, giving the audience an emotional, overjoyed, and tear stained performance of her single, "Going Going Gone." Since her Idol victory, she has been in high demand and gone on to appear and perform on multiple TV shows including Jimmy Kimmel Live, Live! with Kelly & Ryan, the 2018 Radio Disney Music Awards, and performances at the Hollywood Bowl in Los Angeles and the 2018 CMA Fest in Nashville. Maddie embarked on the American Idol Live tour last year.


WITH OPENING ACT

CALEB LEE HUTCHINSON

Caleb Lee Hutchinson was the blond-haired charmer whose crisp baritone and forward-thinking tastes captivated American Idol's 16th season, and with an adventurous batch of original music on the way, he's ready to build on those hints of artistry. One of the genre's finest new vocals reaches back through history and combines with a cutting-edge vision of modern country sonics, as classic meets contemporary in earnest.

Raised in the small town of Dallas, Georgia, just 35 miles west of Atlanta, Hutchinson came by this new generation of three-chords-and-the-truth honestly – while other kids were obsessing over sports, he was doing the same with music. His dad schooled him in classic-country icons like Waylon Jennings and Merle Haggard, his mother loved the electronic energy of '80s pop, and an uncle kept heavy-metal legends like Black Sabbath and Led Zeppelin in constant rotation.

In 2017 he took that spirit to American Idol, moving seamlessly between his love for traditional giants like Keith Whitley and rough-hewn modern stars like Sturgill Simpson. He stood out immediately as fans latched on to his dynamic Southern vocals – just as resonate on Carrie Underwood's "So Small" as they were on Prince's "When Doves Cry" – and by the show's finale he had earned a strong second place finish. But it felt more like a beginning than an end.





In the 1970's the 16 teams split in half leaving 8 to run in Minnesota and 8 in Iowa. Tanner Wangsness of Nashua is the current President. Tanner has been around Chuckwagon racing his whole life. He started racing in 2005. Also ending quite a long run, announcer Rich Greenly will be stepping away after 40 plus years at the end of the season. - There are over **1,750 members of the Butler County Farm Bureau** which makes it one of the largest organization in the county.
- The Butler County Farm Bureau sponsors an Ag in the Classroom coordinator who presents agriculture programs in the classroom utilizing the class's standards and benchmarks. In the past year over 2200 student contacts were made during 115 presentations.
- During National Ag Week, \$300 was given to each of the eight food banks in Butler County.
- Butler County Farm Bureau provides \$7500 in scholarships each year to graduating seniors of Butler County Farm Bureau members.
- Sixty 4-H members in the county whose parents are Butler County Farm Bureau members received \$15 for their membership in their 4-H club.
- Sponsor of the Butler County Fair at the Grand Champion Sponsor level.
- Butler County Farm Bureau donated \$1500 to purchase 4-H trophies.
- Butler County Farm Bureau was a sponsor at the 4th grade Safety Day Camp.
- A health screening was held during Ag Week in March serving 50 people.
- The board of directors is actively engaged with their legislators on ag issues
- The Butler County Farm Bureau hosts the Stroke Detection Plus Screening on a yearly basis to help people detect any risk for stroke before it happens.




