- Educate greater numbers of students
- Focus on basic knowledge & discipline
- Cluster students by age (grade)
- Teacher/lecture model: One size fits all content
- Single subject classes
- Class periods separated by bells
- Students collect packaged credentials at the expense of deep learning
- Focus on ranking and "sorting"—both of schools and students alike


Education built for current environment

NAIS 2013: The Independent School Health Check (snapshot of our student body)


Average Sleep

Professional Mental Health Diagnoses




