What is the CARM Experience Simulation:

- CBSA introduced the CARM Client Portal (CCP) in 2021. Release 2, anticipated in 2023, will enable new commercial assessment and revenue management processes.
- The CARM Experience Simulation will be a hands-on experience with the CARM solution and the CCP's new functionalities.
- Trade community volunteers will be placed in groups.
- Each group will take part in a 4-5 week cycle, experiencing new functionalities/processes (approx. 5-10 hours/ week).
- Your participation and feedback will inform future materials and engagements to aid the broader community in the transition to the new CARM solution.



Who Can Volunteer:

- CBSA is seeking representation from multiple trade community groups: Importers, Non-Resident Importers, Customs Brokers, Trade consultants, Financial security providers, Carriers, Customs Bonded Warehouses.
- To participate you must meet the pre-requisites:
 Importers/Customs Brokers must have registered and if applicable, established delegation of authority on the CCP by May 27, 2022*. Other client types will be advised of requirements once selected to participate. Dedicated resources will support participant onboarding.
- Communication via EDI or API requires test system configuration per <u>ECCRD</u> and readiness to test with and onboard with the CBSA by June 2022.
- Additional requirements will be shared with volunteers based on their group.
- There are limited spots, a lottery may be used to select participants.



When Will It Take Place:

- Kick-off & Onboarding: May-June 2022.
- Cycles are planned to run from July to November.
- Once volunteers are selected, exact timing for your group will be confirmed.
