ECCRD Update

- Chapter 24 ARL Daily Notice and Statement of Account
 - Pre-Draft release provided March 10th
- Chapter 26 CARM CAD
 - Received 110+ feedback items from TCPs, for which 90+ have been responded to and actioned
 - Content updated on an ongoing basis
 - The next draft is expected to include:
 - 20+ Scenarios to depict typical and/or requested declaration entries
 - \circ New sub-sections to provide additional information (Pre-CARM Adjustments, Mass Adjustments, etc.)
 - Updated MIG and completed code lists/tables for type codes, including descriptions
- Release of Final Draft is to be determined
 - Publication date will be at least one year prior to CARM Go-Live
- CARM will continue to collaboratively engage the TCP community; as <u>questions</u> and <u>feedback items</u> are received, they are recorded in their respective logs/databases and published to GCcollab on Wednesdays. To date CARM has responded to 300+ TCP questions and feedback items.










CARM Communications Campaign is On Hold
