

Clubs Clubs Textured Landscape "Painting" with Fabric

INSTRUCTOR: KATHY KEENE



Moonlight on the Birches Saturday, October 18 9:00 – 4:00 pm

Join Kathy Keene and learn how to create these beautiful landscape "painting" using a variety of fabrics. No sewing is involved. Your finished product will look like a watercolor painting! These classes are nature inspired and will be a favorite art piece of yours for many years. Samples on the left are also on display in the shop. Class size is limited so sign up early.

Technique Class

Ruler Techniques: Tucker Trimmer and Wing Clipper

Monday, October 20, 5p – 7:30p Instructor: Mary

- The Wing Clipper is a must have tool if you are making Flying Geese units for your quilt. This tool, and the associated Fast Flying Geese construction technique, allow you to make four finished units from five squares. The best part is that each unit is constructed slightly oversized so each can be trimmed to a perfect size.
- The Tucker Trimmer I tool was designed to help quilter's quickly and easily trim down units that are made with triangles: half square triangle squares, quarter square triangle squares (hourglass units), and combinations of half square and quarter square triangle squares (combination units). The ruler guide lines and unit seam lines help to quickly locate the exact center of pieced units. This makes trim down easy, precise, and perfect every time

Technique Class

Posh Penelope with Quick Curve Ruler

Wednesday, November. 12, 5-8 pm Instructor: Dianne

This is a technique class for creating the Posh Penelope block using the Quick Curve ruler. You will make one block in class, but you can use 3 for a table runner or 4 for a wall hanging, or a bunch for a quilt! It's a great way to use up leftovers from previous projects. (Think baby quilts or Christmas fabrics!) You will need the Sew Kind of Wonderful Posh Penelope pattern and the Quick Curve ruler for this class.


Beginning Free Motion: A Domestic Machine Quilting Class

Carry essentials in style with this handy fold-up organizer. It has mesh and vinyl pockets for visible storage. A deep zippered pocket on the bottom on the inside is perfect for larger items. A zippered pocket on the outside conceals a hanging strap that enables the organizer to be hung from a hook.

Get the remainder of your supply list when you sign up! **Class: \$35.00 (includes pattern).**






Technique Class
