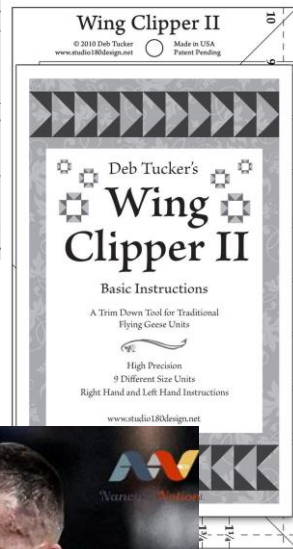
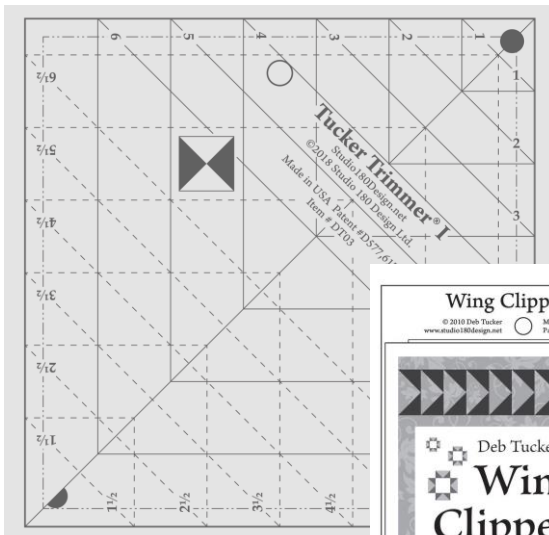


MARY'S RULER TUTORIALS

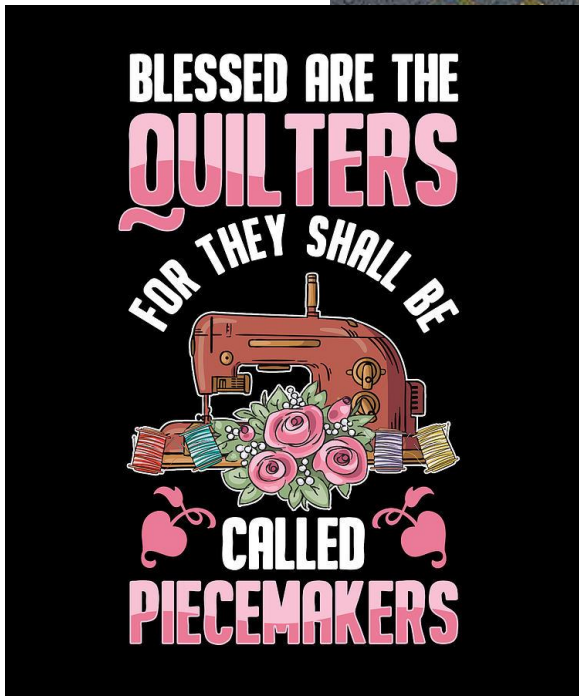
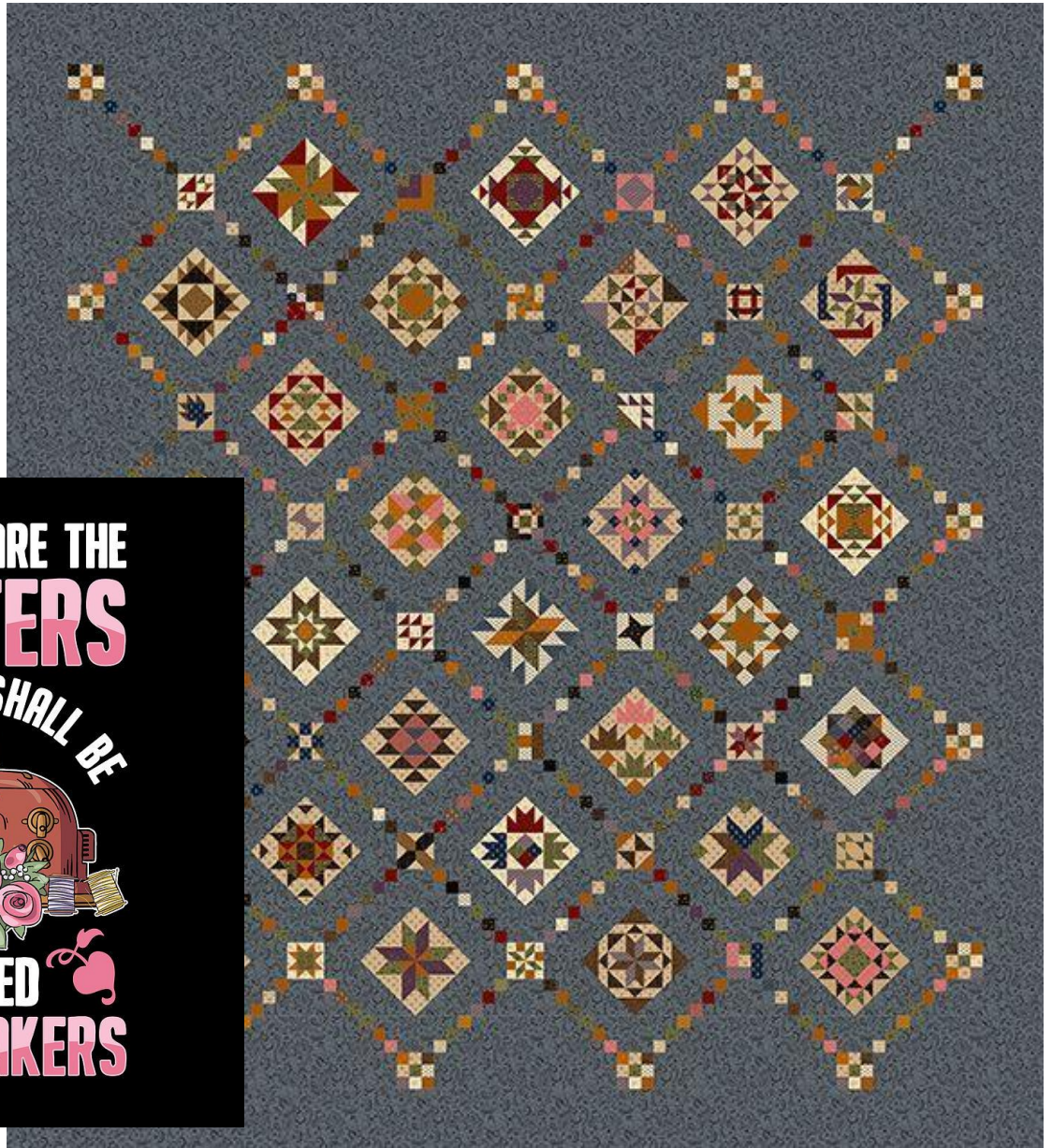
Beginning on Sunday, May 7, we will be **Closed on Sundays** until Sunday, October 1.

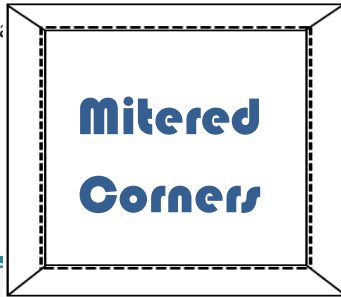
Mitered Corners

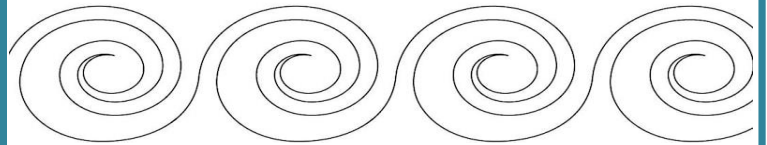
Beginning Free Motion Quilting Class

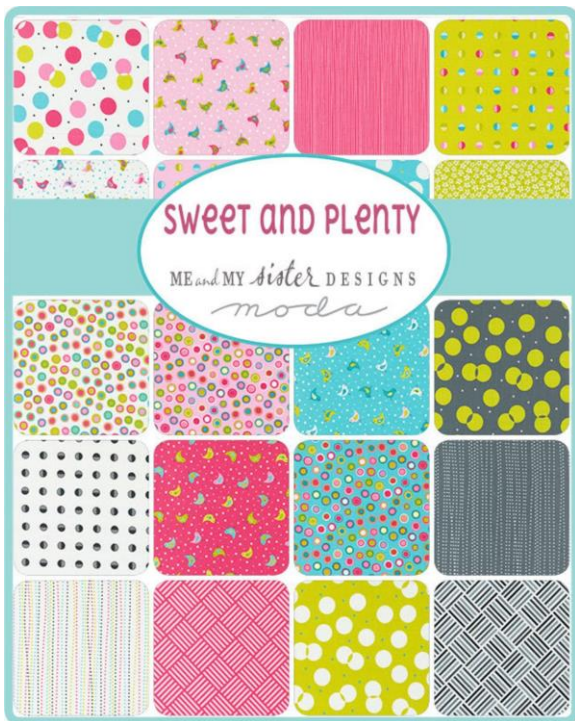


Sample of a block quilt using sashing.

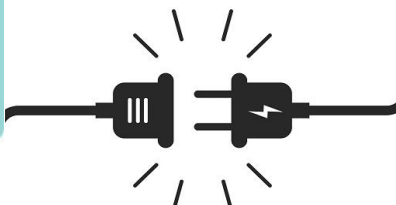
