Did you know . . .

-The word "quilt" comes from the Latin word "culcita" a cushion or mattress, however, in the English language it came around 1250's from the French word "cuilte".

-Quilting was brought to Europe by crusaders from the Middle East in the 11th century. -According to many studies, the first known quilted garment is on the carved ivory figure of a Pharaoh of the Egyptian First Dynasty who was known as the beardless king who wore a white crown, about 3400 B.C.

-One of the oldest surviving bed quilts is the one coming from Sicily from the end of the 14th century. It's made out of linen and it's padded with wool, while the first American quilt is the Saltonstall one from 1704.

-The quilt-making business started to flourish in the period between 1825 – 1875. Back then, quilt covers were used on beds, as covers for doors and windows, as well as floor mats where children used to play. The fumiest fact is that in some places, guilts were used as currency to pay bills. That's how important they were!


SWEATSHIRT TRANSFORMATION


