
Luxe Throw Class

What is a fat quarter of fabric? A fat quarter is a quarter yard cut differently than a regular quarter of fabric. A fat quarter measures 18 inches by 22 inches, nearly forming a square of fabric. To create a fat quarter, cut a half-yard of fabric 18 inches along its lengthwise grain, then cut that piece in half at its midpoint.



The fabric choices are endless. You can make it really scrappy or plan it out like Mary is (see square below).

This is your chance to master a STAR, whether creating with traditional fabrics or something a little "out of the box"! The size of your quilt is up to you. Directions are included for baby, throw, twin or king size.

Have fun creating these great stars while mastering a perfect point every time! Mary will show you all the tricks!




V Block Ruler Class






