
Beginning Paper Piecing




Table Topper of the Month!





QUILT SEEDS KITS!

The Piece & Plenty Quilt Seeds Patterns by Lori Holt of *Bee in My Bonnet* is a pattern series of 4 different basket quilt blocks filed with bright flowers.

Each seed packet/kit has instructions to make 1 block. A paper pattern is included in each packet/kit, along with the fabric. No templates are required. Each block finishes at 24" x 30" and uses traditional piecing techniques.

Collect all 4 of these beautiful seed packets in their keepsake packaging. Optional quilt finishing instructions will be included in each packet/kit. Seed packet size is approximately 6 1/2" x 9 1/2".


