




Abundant pockets in a variety of styles are the key to ensuring that there is a place for everything... and that everything is in its place!

Make sure to seal your quilted edges by sewing 1/8". All prep work must be done at class time. If not, it is up to you to catch up. The rest of the class will continue on. Please come a little early so we can start on time.

Sunday, February 2 Noon until 4:00pm








Table Topper of the Month!

Wonder Curve Ruler




The Piece & Plenty

bright flowers.


Each seed packet/kit has instructions to make 1 block. A paper pattern is included in each packet/kit, along with the fabric. No templates are required. Each block finishes at 24" x 30" and uses traditional piecing techniques.

Collect all 4 of these beautiful seed packets in their keepsake packaging. Optional quilt finishing instructions will be included in each packet/kit. Seed packet size is approximately 6 1/2" x 9 1/2".
