2023 SUMMER READING PROGRAM! "All Together Now"

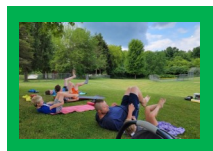

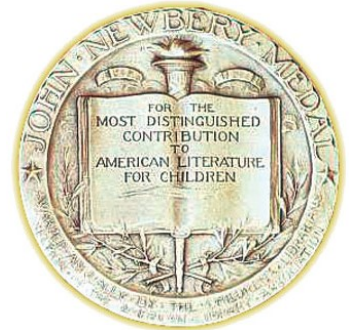

Celebrating Caldecott & Newbery Authors at EFL

Have you ever noticed that some children’s books have a shiny gold or silver medal on their cover? The Caldecott and Newbery Medals have been annually awarded by the Association for Library Service to Children, a division of the American Library Association for



almost one hundred years. The Caldecott Medal, named in honor of nineteenth-century English illustrator Randolph Caldecott, is given to the artist of the most distinguished American picture book for children. The Newbery Medal, named for eighteenth-century British bookseller John Newbery is given to the author of the most distinguished contribution to American literature for children. At the Elbridge Free Library on Wednesdays @ 10:30 this sum-



mer, Ms. Benga has been exploring lots of her favorite medal winning books with the Advanced Adventures group (8+). All are welcome to come and explore. Look for some of the previous winners on our shelves and on the display to the right as you enter the children’s room.
