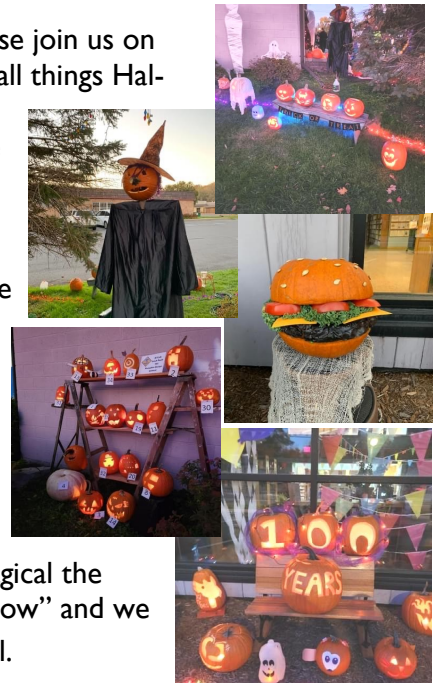


4th ANNUAL PUMPKIN WALK

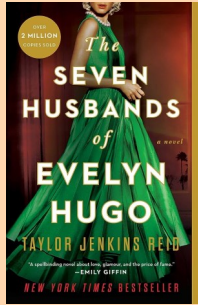
JORDAN ELBRIDGE 1st GRADE STUDENTS TO TAKE FIELD TRIP TO LIBRARY
