Saturday Clubs for Kids

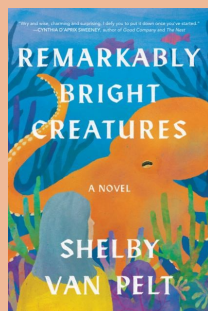

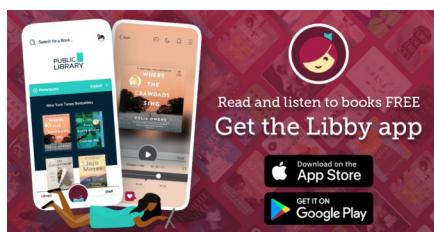
