### What is this workshop about?

This workshop explained ethical research. The workshop explained how people living with intellectual/developmental disabilities can be meaningfully included in research. They can be either researchers or participants. Workshop participants did activities that explained what inclusive ethical research is and what it is not.



### Why is this workshop important?

This workshop explained the importance of inclusive ethical research. Inclusive ethical research makes sure research participants are not at risk of harm. It is important to consider people's human rights when doing inclusive ethical research. It is important to get informed consent from research participants. Informed consent means participants understand the risks and benefits of the research. Informed consent also means participants have a chance to ask questions.

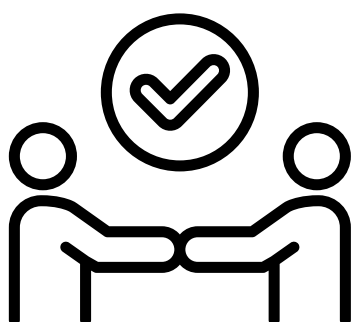
## How did they do the workshop at PARN?

The presenters had two activities. The first activity explained inclusive ethical research, the second activity explained informed consent.

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In the first activity, people were split up into small groups. The groups were given a case study about a person who wanted to participate in research. They shared their ideas about whether the case study was or was not ethical research. They also had a chance to talk about what they learned.



In the second activity, groups read two consent forms. They discussed whether or not they were good examples of consent forms. Each group shared their ideas with the larger group.
