





## What is this workshop about?



This workshop explained what photovoice is. Photovoice is a research method where people take photos and use them to come together to Voice Our Individual and Collective Experiences (VOICE).

# Why is this workshop important?




This workshop showed how photovoice allows people to express themselves using photos. This is good for people who do not communicate by talking. This empowers people.

# How did they do the workshop at PARN?



The presenters explained how to do photovoice research. They explained that photovoice is an inclusive method and also has some challenges.

Then the presenters described a photovoice project called 'Voices Lost in Crisis.' They described how Covid-19 pandemic felt for people living with intellectual/developmental disabilities.



Journaling is also part of photovoice research. Participants practiced journaling along with some photos. Participants wrote about the 'who, what, when, where and why' that they saw in the photos.
