This goal addresses a multitude of issues including education, health care, language and cultural barriers, access to social

HISTORY: We began our work with the local Haitian community in 2005. Each year we have strengthened our efforts and expanded our programs as we provide educational programs for adults and children in the Haitian community.

How would the donated funds be used?	Funds would be used to support our food pantry. Currently we are providing dry goods, meats, fruits, veggies, bread and pastries to 100+ families a week as well as 500+ meals-to-eat per week, many of these to the homeless.
How much of the funds are used for Admin Expenses?	Our administrative staff is 100% voluntary. We do have overhead for rent, utilities & general supplies = \$2000/month.
What are the current sources of funding for the organization?	Allegany Franciscan Ministries, United Way of Palm Beach County, individual donors & the BOD.
What population does the organization serve?	local Haitian immigrant community in PBC, both adults and children.

How would The Donated Funds Be Used?	1) food bank: food, gas stipend for those who work the food bank, 2) rent & utilities support for clients most in need.

performed?	At our office, 25 S H Street, Lake Worth, FL 33460
How do you measure your program success?	We measure success of the food pantry by # of families served per week with food, and # of families served per month with rent & utilities support.
What past success have you achieved?	We have worked with a single, handicapped mother of 3 young boys, one who is mentally handicapped, for 7 years. We provide this family with food, and assistance with applications and local resources as needed. The mother, Rose Marie, is currently doing very well taking care of her 3 young boys. We are in continuous contact with her, making sure she has what she needs to provide for her young boys.
What methods will be used to measure results?	1) We keep a daily log of all programs: food pantry, individual support, and follow up with families who receive financial support. 2) we work very closely with our 'Children's Enrichment Program' families - staying in constant contact with them and offering them social services as available.
