



Faith Farm, a ministry operated by Lutheran Services Carolinas, provides transitional housing for homeless female veterans. Faith Farm's program director and several residents will join us at the Ninth Triennial Gathering, helping participants better understand the reality that women are the fastest-growing segment of the homeless veteran population.



Visit with program director Sharon Johnston and several residents in the Dor (the exhibit hall), learning about the plight of this generation of women serving in the military. On Friday and Saturday afternoon join in a servant event where participants will write to women in active military duty.

"In talking with the women at Faith Farm, we learned how important it is for women to stay connected to other women while they are out alone in military service," explains Valora K Starr, Women of the ELCA staff who is overseeing the servant events. "The veterans said that a caring note from someone back home, even a stranger, can make all the difference." Stationery and pens will be provided. Monetary donations for postage, or the gift of first class stamps, will be received on site in Charlotte.

BLOOD DRIVE

Gathering planners have just announced a blood drive to be held Friday, July 25, between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. in Room 211B-212B of the Charlotte Convention Center. The American Red Cross, hosting the blood drive, notes that blood is especially needed this time of year.

To schedule an appointment, participants should use the sponsor code "WELCA" when visiting the Red Cross website. Use the blue box on the upper right hand page that reads "Give blood. Find a blood drive."



On site appointments will be available at the gathering's registration desk on both July 24 and 25.
