Consider Being a Delegate to the 2014 Triennial Gathering

Three delegates to the 2014 Triennial Gathering will be elected at the Synodical Convention in November. The 9th Triennial Gathering will take place at Charlotte, N.C. July 22-24, 2014. The Triennial Gathering is the highest legislative authority of Women of the ELCA.

Delegates you will represent all the women in the Pacifica Synod and cast votes on their behalf. The delegates are expected to be at all convention business meetings, to listen to discussion of issues that require a vote, help set the budget, elect the executive board and officers, and hear committee reports and vote on their recommendations.

Prior to the convention, delegates receive the convention program and reports so they can arrive prepared to thoughtfully vote on the issues. Churchwide is responsible for your transportation, most meals and room (shared with another synod delegate). The delegate's responsibility ends when the business meetings are over, but most stay at their own expense for the Gathering that follows.
