## "Wrapped in God's Love and Comfort"

The women at Hope L.C. in Palm Desert are busy creating love, comfort and warmth for children in a practical way. Even in the torrid heat of summer!

Our Quilters of Hope work 2 to 3 Wednesday mornings a month to meet our commitment to the LWR Quilt Challenge. We have a "Workshop Wednesday" once a month to work on ministry projects and some crafting and sewing is done at home. The items made for children are: Fleece Scarves, Decorative Pillowcases, Knitted and Crocheted Caps and blankets, Quilts and Lovey Dolls. Our 2013 focus is helping the children of migrant farm workers in the Coachella Valley. At our SWO Event in March, you helped us by cutting and tying 47 fleece scarves. It was a GREAT kickoff and we thank you all!

Hope member, Junelle Pearson, RN introduced the Lovey Dolls and has inspired us with her experiences in Africa, China and Peru giving the dolls to orphaned children through Cross Cultural Solutions. These Lovey Dolls have not only blessed children in foreign countries, they have been a local blessing. The Brownie Troop that meets at Hope assembled dolls, learning where they were going and what they would mean to a child in another country. Also, at the March event, 39 dolls were made. Patterns were provided for more to be made at other churches in the Synod. Our Snowbirds do the same at their home churches across the country. Lovey Dolls have been given to babies and children here in Riverside County who live challenging lives. This may be due to homelessness, medical, financial or domestic issues.

The Eastern Riverside Chapter of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans has provided tremendous support to our local projects through their Care in Communities grant.
