It is planned to have this Fund grow to one million dollars by July 24, 2014 when the women begin their Triennial Gathering in Charlotte, NC. Everyone is asked to donate to this wonderful project. 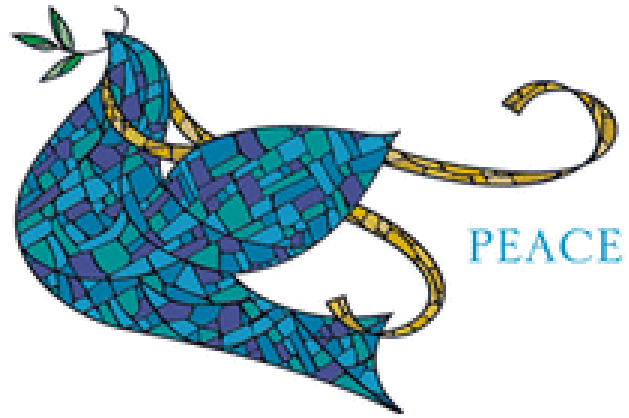

## What Do You Believe?

*This is a story as it was told to me by three friends to whom it happened. They are all members of our prayer team and the leader is an ordained minister.*

*One day they had met at a local coffee house to talk with the team leader about some doubts two of them were having, when a man approached the outside table where they were sitting. He stopped and said to them "I see you are reading the bible". They looked up and saw a man smiling at them. As they smiled back, they notice that his clothes were somewhat worn and soiled and he had a scruffy beard. It was apparent he had been drinking although he did not seem intoxicated. Since he seemed attracted by their bible reading the leader invited him to join them.*

*Obviously pleased to be invited, he pulled up a chair and sat down. One of them asked, "Do you have a favorite bible verse?" He said he did. Expecting that it would be a popular verse that everyone would know, they were surprised when he said, "It is Hebrews 13:2."*

*Since none of them knew that one by heart they turned to their bibles.*

*Hebrews 13:2 (KJV) – "Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares."*

*After a few more minutes of conversation about faith, and this particular verse, he stood and said "Well I have to be going. Have a blessed day." The three of them stared at each other and then as one turned to look in the direction he had walked. He was gone!*

*What had happened this day? Who had these friends met? Was it just a man who was looking for some companionship and acceptance he rarely gets or could it have been "an angel unawares?" To this day I don't think they are sure.*

*Think about this, my friends. The next time God gives you the opportunity to offer hospitality to a stranger "be not forgetful" to take that opportunity. After all, you might miss meeting an angel.*

## **The Nicene Creed**

*So, what's so special about Easter anyway?*

*At Easter, Christians around the world celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, a pivotal belief of our Christian faith. What makes it so special to Christians?*

*In a first letter to the Corinthian church (1 Corinthians 15:12), the Apostle Paul tells us that if Christ has not risen, neither will we, which would make our faith useless and without merit.*

*At the Council of Nicaea in 325 AD, 318 bishops from the Greek-speaking and Latin-speaking portions of the Roman Empire gathered to debate and refute what was defined as the Arian heresy denying the deity of Christ. (Arius, a fourth-century Christian presbyter from Alexandria, Egypt, taught that Christ was a created being and not divine.)*

*But at Nicaea, the bishops debated and reaffirmed the deity of Christ, describing it as such in the Nicene Creed, for conformity of doctrine, reaffirming the nature of Christ with these words: "true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things are made." Thus, reaffirming that Jesus Christ, as the Son of God, is both divine (being co-equal and co-eternal with the Father), and human, being conceived in the womb of the Virgin Mary (His incarnation), which we celebrate at Christmas.*

*The first chapter of John's Gospel refers to Christ in a similar way: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."*

*During the early Church, Christians did not have individual Bibles, and most people were not highly literate—even the clergy often lacked a comprehensive knowledge of the Scriptures, giving rise to a misunderstanding of the Bible. That is why the Council at Nicaea found it necessary to discuss, debate and reaffirm the nature of Christ, elucidating it for us as the Nicene Creed, as a basis for understanding the Christian faith regarding the nature of Christ, as well as restating and affirming His death and His resurrection.*

*Because He is truly man, He could atone, on our behalf, for our sins. Because He is truly divine, His passion and death constituted an unblemished sin offering to a Holy God. And because of His resurrection we have both the assurance of our own resurrection and guarantee of eternal life.*

*Yes, He is risen! He has risen indeed! Alleluia!*

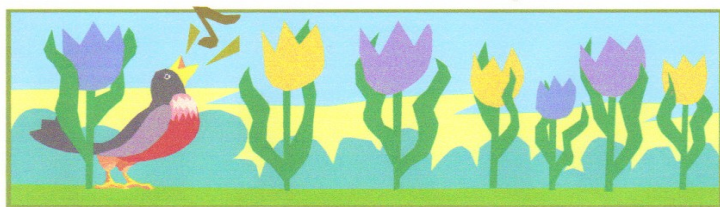
