



July 7, 2011: The Members of Christ Lutheran are now beginning the process of clearing the site and preparing to begin their new building. They are still in need of prayers

Christ Lutheran was established in 1922. We are a small congregation with a traditional worship service Due to the tornadoes in the Southeast in April of 2011, our church was destroyed. In March, the city council approved our plans and as soon as the architect finalizes that blueprints, we will begin plans on selecting a contractor. It is estimated that it will take approximately 6 months to build once we break ground.

We are grateful to the many congregations and individuals who have given so generously to our church. This will allow us to rebuild and furnish our church. Thank you so much!

We are currently worshiping in the chapel at Sacred Heart Convent, 916 Convent Road, on Sunday mornings at 11:30. We have a fellowship hour beginning at 10:30.

We have adult Sunday School from 10:00 to 10:30 and youth from 10:30 to 11:00

Our temporary office is located in the Ponder Building, Suite 102 in downtown Cullman. Please address all correspondence to our mailing address, PO Box 974, Cullman, AL 35056

On Monday, March 5th, the City of Cullman Planning Commission formally approved Christ Lutheran's building plans. We will now begin taking bids on the project. Rebuilding will begin later in the spring, with a projected completion date of winter 2012. I will update the blog to reflect our progress.




