VENTING TO A FRIEND OR WRITING IN A JOURNAL

To cope with stress, immediately blowing off steam is the wrong way to go, according to a recent study from the University of Kent in England. The researchers found that angstriddenn subjects who first vented to a friend often ended up feeling worse afterward. Instead, try putting pen to paper before talking to a pal, suggest Ellen K. Baker, a D.C.-based psychologist. "You can express negative feelings without worrying about being judged," she says. Once you've gotten your frustrations out, ask a friend to help you find "humor," or a "silver lining," in the situation. That, is the most effec-
