

#### **Too Busy** by Juli Patten

The infamous lament of women everywhere is "I am too busy!" It can come up when we are asked "How is your day or even what have you been doing? While being a wife, mother, employee, boss, housekeeper, cook etc. can be taxing and overwhelming we continue to do all we think we should. We continue to say yes when asked to do just one more thing.

In our faith life sometimes we are too busy to share. We are faithful and we love the lord. We attend services, bake cookies, attend committee meetings, clean the sanctuary, volunteer in the nursery etc. anything and everything to serve our church family, just like our own family.

When my pastor gives a sermon on evangelism I have a tendency to sink down in my pew and hide with a certain amount of shame. I am too busy to be an evangelist. I don't have time to share my faith and get people to come to church.

I am very connected by technology and receive over 40 emails a day in my personal account not counting my various other email accounts. So I really feel I am too busy for all the cute stories amazing pictures and chain letters that get sent via email. Even though this is true occasionally the subject will hook me and I have to open it. The other day I got one of those emails the subject was 3 bullets. Well you can see why it grabbed me.

#### 3 Bullets...

There once was a man who had nothing for his family to eat. He had an old rifle and three bullets. So, he decided that he would go out hunting and kill some wild game for dinner. 


