

So you're going to Minneapolis? Check out these apps!


We know you'll stay busy with all the <u>Tenth Triennial Gathering</u> <u>activities</u>: worship, plenaries, servant events, workshops, visiting vendors and exhibits and, of course, shopping.

But when you do get out into the city, there are plenty of apps to help you get around. Go to the app store on your device to download these and other apps.

We like the **Sky Walker – Minneapolis Skyways** app. It's a navigation tool for Minneapolis skyways or inside walking areas. You can stay out of the heat and avoid construction using this app.

Other apps you can find in the app store include:

Minneapolis Travel Guide and Offline City Street Maps, a travel app that allows you to ditch the books



Minneapolis Saint Paul Official Visitor's Guide to the Twin Cities area, published by local convention and visitors' bureaus

Minneapolis Transit Tracker helps you maneuver the Metro Transit System

MPLS Parking, a convenient way to pay for parking using your phone

Minneapolis St. Paul MSP Airport Guide, a flight and travel planning tool

MPLS Drinker: Happy Hour Finder (need we say more?)

Minneapolis Latest News shows news published by local media

MPR News (Minnesota Public Radio) provides up-to-date, in-depth coverage of important developments in the region

Transportation from the airport:

- Taxi service Transportation time to and from the Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport is about 10-15 minutes and is available outside baggage claim area for approximately \$39-\$49 each way.
- **SuperShuttle** is offering triennial gathering participants a discount for using their service at the Minneapolis/Saint Paul International Airport. The cost is \$15 one way or \$24 round trip to anyone who uses the discount code online or at the airport desk.
- Light Rail Transit (LRT) trains stop at both airport Terminal 1-Lindbergh and Terminal 2-Humphrey and connect travelers to 17 other destinations, including downtown Minneapolis to the north and Mall of America to the south. Tickets are sold at ticket machines at the rail stations. Light rail fares for adults are \$2.25 during rush hours (Monday through Friday, 6 to 9 a.m. and 3 to 6:30 p.m.) and \$1.75 at other times. (Trains run every 10 minutes during peak hours & typically every 10 to 15 min. at other times of the day. From the airport, trains can take you to Mall of America in about 12 minutes and to downtown Minneapolis in about 25 minutes).

SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

- If you are looking to purchase backpacks, the preferred style is often used in the U.S. for youth to carry athletic equipment. Try your local sporting goods store or search online using the keywords, "buy drawstring backpacks."
- Before purchasing backpacks, make sure they meet the size requirements (14" x17") and General Assembly Instructions. You can download a list from our website of suppliers who have appropriate bags available for purchase in bulk.
- · Please give new items only.
- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your group's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
- Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.
- Do not enclose the Kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.

INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH SCHOOL KIT

- FOUR 70-sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper, approximately 8" x 10 ½"; no loose leaf paper
- ONE 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- ONE pencil sharpener
- ONE pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- FIVE unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- FIVE black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band
- ONE box of 16 or 24 crayons
- ONE 2 1/2" eraser
- ONE sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag, approximately 14" x 17" with shoulder straps (no standard backpacks)

HOW TO PACK YOUR PROJECT PROMISE KITS

- Place ruler between notebooks. Place all items neatly into the bag and draw the drawstring together.
- Pack completed Kits, like items together, in boxes.
 Label contents in LARGE, BLOCK LETTERS on the outside of the boxes.
- Use strong cartons secured with packing tape, not to exceed 40 pounds.
- Do not use plastic or paper bags to pack donations.
- Include the name and address of your group or congregation on each box and label the contents

FABRIC KITS

SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER


- · Fabric should have no stains or holes.
- Pieces do not need to match in size or color/pattern as long as they fit into one of the three size options.
- Each spool of thread should match one of the pieces of fabric included. Neutral thread is also a good option.
- Please give new items only.
- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your group's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
- Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.
- Do not enclose the Kit or any of its contents in plastic bags

HOW TO PACK YOUR PROJECT PROMISE KITS

- Wrap one piece of fabric and spools of thread inside the other piece of fabric, ensuring nothing will fall out. Secure with yarn, ribbon, string or rubber bands.
- Pack completed Kits, like items together, in boxes.
 Label contents in LARGE, BLOCK LETTERS on the outside of the boxes.
- Use strong cartons secured with packing tape, not to exceed 40 pounds.
- Include the name and address of your group or congregation on each box and label the contents.

INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH FABRIC KIT

- **TWO** spools of neutral-colored, general purpose thread, 250-300 yards each
- TWO pieces of cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits of 100% polyester). Each piece should match one of the sizes below:
 - 2 1/4 yards of 60" wide fabric
 - 3 vards of 44" wide fabric
 - 4 yards of 36" wide fabric
