From the President's Desk



Our convention planning team continues their work on the program parts of the convention – we don't have a lot of new information. The next *Pacficia Partners* will be delivered October 1 – keep watching our website, www.pacificawomen.com, as more information will posted as the exciting details develop! Our new website manager/newsletter editor is doing a super fabulous job and has responded immediately to any new requests or any necessary correction. Remember Gwen Edwards is from our partner synod in Nebraska – so think of our way of connecting to our sister synod – it is quite unique! At our June board meeting, it was decided our

convention offerings (both Praise/Unit offering and individual offerings taken at closing worship) will be shared 50% to churchwide, 25% to our synodical budget, and 25% to our seminary scholarship fund.

Gerri Licke has agreed to be our nominations chair and the nomination form is on our the website and included in this issue. We will be electing a vice president by nominating ballot. The nomination team needs to find nominees for treasurer and ideally, five board positions. Our treasurer is eligible to be re-elected to a second term. Three current board members have another year in their term and the other three are eligible for to be re-elected to a second term. Pacifica SWO should have eight board members (we have six this year), therefore, we are looking for at least two additional women willing to serve. If you know of someone you would like to see serve on our board, fill out the form and send it to Gerri – or call her. She or her team will communicate with the woman/women you suggest to see if they are willing to serve. If YOU would like to serve, fill out the form and email or call Gerri.

Remember that we also have scholarships available for our convention. The form is in this issue and on the website.

Once again, we will hold a Silent Auction which is how we raise the monies for our convention and triennial gathering scholarships. See the article in their issue.

Since we have been meeting in a church rather than a hotel, we have been able to offer one day registration. The last couple of years, we have worked to make that one day packed with programming. This year we will still offer the one day registration and are working to spread out the business and programming, so that you will want to be there both days to ensure you don't miss anything! Voting members are required to be there both days.

At the June board meeting, we awarded a \$500 scholarship to Emily Erisman who will be attending Wartburg Seminary. She is from Bethlehem in Encinitas.

Also at the June board meeting, we agreed to send \$1200 to Churchwide Women of the ELCA to help pay for one of our voting members at the Triennial Convention. Churchwide Executive Board had suggested each synod pay \$2400 for one voting member to help balance the budget for the event, the convention total budget is \$741,530. We are a small synod (in numbers, not geography!) and felt we had enough resources to pay \$1200 now and then may be able to send more at the end of the year.

Keep thinking of and planning to attend the Triennial Gathering in Phoenix July 14-16, 2020. Registration will open September 30 and nominations are now open until November 30 for the two officers and seventeen women to serve on the Churchwide Executive Board; the president and vice-president are elected by a nominating ballot process. In February 2019, our board voted to transfer \$2000 from our convention scholarship fund to triennial scholarships. Perhaps because the costs for attending our convention in a church are lower, we have had fewer requests for convention scholarships. Therefore, at present, we have \$1,644 available for convention and \$2,710 available for triennial scholarships. The forms to apply for those scholarships are in this issue and on the website. Don't let funds keep you from experiencing "Just Love" – the worship, the music, the speakers - which will be in Phoenix!!


