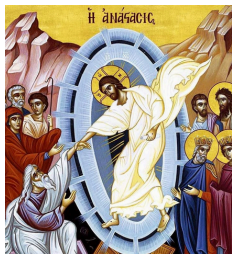


Holy Saturday Evening: The Resurrection

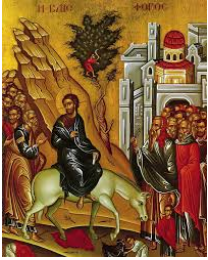

Palm Sunday: Morning Liturgy



On Palm Sunday, during liturgy, we commemorate the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem after raising Lazarus from the dead. The people greet Him shouting praises.

Receive your palm cross from Father.



Holy Wednesday Afternoon: Sacrament of Holy Unction



During this service, we receive the sacrament of Holy Unction. The priest anoints us with oil for the healing of soul and body and the forgiveness of sins.

Receive your Holy Unction from Father.



Holy Thursday Evening: The Twelve Gospels

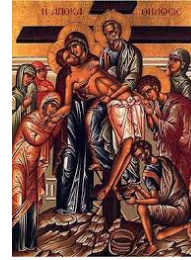


On Holy Thursday evening, we read twelve Gospel readings about the betrayal, crucifixion and burial of Jesus (His Passion). We remember that He died for our sins.

Kiss Christ on the Cross.



Holy Friday Afternoon: The Descent from the Cross



During this service, we see Jesus being taken down from the Cross and laid in the tomb, the *Epitaphio*. The priest lays Jesus in a white cloth after he removes Him from the Cross.

Go under Christ's tomb.



Holy Friday Evening: Matins Service

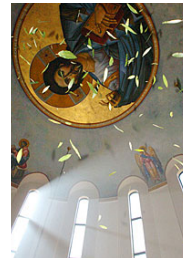


On Holy Friday Evening, we remember Jesus' burial and time in the tomb. We sing special hymns called the *Egomia* and follow the *Epitaphio* around in a procession.

Try singing one of the *Egomia*.



Holy Saturday Morning: Morning Liturgy



During this service, we prepare for the Resurrection on Easter Sunday. Watch to see the priest tossing palm leaves and wishing everyone a good Resurrection.

Bang on the pews to proclaim the First Resurrection.
