Course Description

The Foundational Hand was developed by the Calligrapher and Typographer Edward Johnston in the early 20th Century. It is based on his study of the Ramsay Psalter, a 10th century Carolingian manuscript written in Winchester, England, which is now in the British Museum. Foundational has been taught as a basic alphabet in England for some time. It is very legible and is often used for longer texts. Many of our modern typefaces are based on it. This course is suitable for beginners. All levels welcome!

Materials

Pilot Parallel Pen (2.4mm) or
Penholder, Ink, Speedball C-3 nib or Mitchell size 2 or Brause 2mm nib
Pencil, ruler, eraser
Grid paper (4 or 5 squares to the inch), 1 or two sheets of plain paper (can be marker paper)
