Safe Passage bridges the gaps & barriers for children who live in poverty. We provide pathways to succeed as future leaders regardless of living conditions.


Who We Serve

Our Impact

In 2023, Safe Passage reduced gang crimes and reduced drug use by youth.

As of January 2024, Safe Passage had reduced the local total gang population by 47% and reduced overall crime by 49% in under-served Micro-Communities.

Vocational and Workforce Training

The weekly Youth Corps program is designed to provide early career training and employment opportunities to teens.

By focusing on providing vocational and career training in a community service setting, this program aims to prepare young people for the workforce and help them secure a better future for themselves. Most teens are the first generation in their families to graduate from high school.

The Youth Corps has a positive impact on academic performance.



According to a study by the Corporation for National and Community Service, students who participate in service programs such as the Youth Corps have higher grades, higher graduation rates, and are more likely to attend college.

FOR YOUTH PROSPERITY



Project Sheer Promise. We provide regular free haircuts from professional barbers for these high risk teens. It improves their self esteem and they get a 30 minute mentoring session while in the Barber's Seat.

STOP GANG RECRUITMENT

A third grader does not wake up and say to themselves: " I think I'll be a gang member in middle school." They succumb overtime to recruitment efforts because they perceive there are no other good alternatives.

Police Officers, CRPD recreation leaders and gang counselors supervise the WEEKLY activities that include workshops on self worth and self esteem, mental health counseling, teamwork, anger management and literacy.



What is GAP? Safe Passage Youth staff meets every day with our partner organizations and we tailor individual wrap-around programs to meet each "high- risk" child's needs.

Our Impact

In 2023, Safe Passage created free evening teen clubs that provide GAP identified HIGH RISK youth with hot dinners, mentors, recreation and safe spaces to keep them off of the streets.
