## NOTICE TO HANDLERS

Test/Trial site will be available from 8:00am to 4:00pm

No unentered dogs (except for set-out dogs) will be allowed in the test/trial arenas during the event. Bring your own towels. Please bring your own chairs, canopy, dog supplies, etc. It could be cool or hot. Also, bring sunscreen and mosquito repellent. There is little shade.

All American Kennel Club rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED.**

Bitches in season will be allowed but must move to the end of the test/trial class. Please notify the Secretary if your bitch is in season.

Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arenas. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Owners or their Agents are responsible for keeping their dogs leashed and under control at all times. Everyone is expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

**A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered.** You may enter more than one Trial/Test for the same dog on one entry form.

Entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies and must include a signed AKC Agreement and Rules for each entry. **Unsigned entry forms will not be accepted.**

**Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** There is a \$25 returned check fee. No conditional entries will be accepted. **Entry forms must be signed.**

All entries will be acknowledged by email from the Event Secretary. Judges Program will be emailed to each entrant.

All entries sent via express delivery must have signature waived. Entries close at the Secretary's address at 6:00pm (Central), on August 22, 2024, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fees shall be made.

The American Beauceron Club, its Board members, and Purina Farms will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

The American Beauceron Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

## AGREEMENT AND RULES

I (WE) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us) and that I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog tested and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock caused by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any livestock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the **full market value (\$250.00)** of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.
