The ATT test is open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Entries limited to 50 dogs per trial. Day of entries will be accepted if each trial doesn't fill, starting at 9:30am and ending at 1:00pm.

Entries open upon publishing of premium. Pre-entries close May 2, 2025 at 6pm at the secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted. When the numerical limit is reached, additional entries will be placed on a wait list. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Entry forms must be signed! Please check entry form before mailing to make sure it is legible, and that all dog's info is correct. Entries sent via FedEx, UPS, or USPS must have signature waived.
- Online entries may be submitted via saltydogscoursing.com
- A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered.
- Dogs must be 1 year of age to participate in the ATT Temperament Test.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- Dogs showing any sign of aggression or soiling the ring will be dismissed.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST

Welcome to the AKC Temperament Test! There are 198 AKC recognized breeds. One of the things that makes a specific breed unique is not only the dog's physical appearance, but each breed also has its own distinctive temperament.

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) was developed to bring focus and provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions. Dogs must be 1 year of age to participate and pass 2 separate tests to qualify for a title.

The ATT tests will show how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation and an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

1. Social
2. Auditory
3. Visual
4. Tactile
5. Proprioceptive (motion)
6. Unexpected stimulus
