**Farm Dog Certification Tests – Open to All Breeds**

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not participate. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

**PRE-Entries Close: January 31, 2025 at 6:00 pm (Central)**

After this time, entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

**FDC Entries limited to 50 tests per event.**

Day of entries will be accepted if maximum limit is not reached at closing.

**ENTRY INFORMATION – FARM DOG TEST**

**ENTRY FEES: Pre-entries: \$20 per dog per run**, includes AKC \$3.50 recording fee. Make checks payable to Salty Dogs Coursing. Day of entries will be taken from 9:30 AM provided there is space available in either test. **Day of entry fee will be \$25 per dog per run. Please note it takes two test passes to earn the title, so cost is per test.**

Confirmations will be sent by e-mail only.

All fees payable to Salty Dogs Coursing, includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee per dog/per run  
If sending entries overnight, make sure to sign waiver that allows the delivery person to leave packages without a signature. Requiring a signature will only delay receipt of your entries.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 collection fee. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly & carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. The Trial Secretary is not responsible for illegible (in the opinion of the Trial Sec) entry form information. May SDC decline entries and may remove any dog on any account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned group or any official or member thereof. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered test, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test, no refund will be made. When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list in the order entry was received. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the event entered. A signed Consent and Release from Liability form must accompany each entry. Failure to do so will result in you and your dog being barred from entering the grounds and competing in these trials.

**RIBBONS:** Each dog that passes a Farm Dog Certification Test will receive a dark green ribbon provided by Salty Dogs Coursing. Dogs that pass Farm Dog Certification Tests under two different judges are eligible for a Farm Dog Certified Title and a white/green rosette.

An application form for the title is included in the premium list for the convenience of exhibitors. Owners will need to complete the application form and send it and the appropriate fee to the American Kennel Club.

**Directions to Trial Site**

GPS Navigate to 21467 Oak Ridge Drive, Robertsedale, AL 36567. Follow Oak Ridge Drive to end of cul de sac. Entrance to The Hey Farm will be on the right side (signs will be posted). Please park in designated areas only.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **Check in will begin at 09:00AM and end at 1:00PM**
- Tests will begin at 09:00AM and will be run concurrently.
- Dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting, flat collar during the test evaluation and be held on a proper fixed-length leash at all times while on the farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel, or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. No prong or electronic collars, head halters, harnesses, or flexi-leads are permitted during the tests.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION (cont'd)

- You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in the proper receptacles. A failure to do so could result in you and your dog being dismissed from the trial grounds and be barred from competing with no refund given.
- Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting herding stock nor to interfere outside the testing area with another dog's performance in the test areas. The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time, if she determines the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs or persons on the farm.
- Bitches in season may not enter.
- No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same judge at any test.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Course Director will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging.

## **AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST**

Welcome to the AKC Temperament Test! There are 198 AKC recognized breeds. One of the things that makes a specific breed unique is not only the dog's physical appearance, but each breed also has its own distinctive temperament.

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) was developed to bring focus and provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions. Dogs must be 1 year of age to participate and pass 2 separate tests to qualify for a title.

The ATT tests will show how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation and an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

1. Social
2. Auditory
3. Visual
4. Tactile
5. Proprioceptive (motion)
6. Unexpected stimulus

**Entry Information:** Entries close **January 31, 2025** at 6pm Central, at which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions, corrections or cancellations of entries must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

Dogs showing any sign of aggression or soiling the ring will be dismissed.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.
