Dear Parishioners:

This year, we are making a few changes to our 2026 Lenten Friday Fish Dinners.

We will again be serving either baked cod or haddock – the chef's weekly choice. The fish loins are 8-oz wild-caught, frozen, boneless, and skinless. The menu will vary each week, with hearty portions of either rice or potatoes, a vegetable, and a side dish, salad, or dessert, along with coffee and beverages. Fish sticks and Mac & Cheese are available for children aged 12 and under, at no cost.

We are changing the dinner serving time from 4:30 – 6:00 p.m. instead of the long-standing 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. This is to accommodate the regular Friday evening Mass and devotion schedule that was implemented last year, where the 5:30 p.m. Mass is now immediately followed by other devotions such as the Rosary, the Stations of the Cross, Adoration, and other prayers. This will allow people to have a quick dinner prior to attending Mass, and those not going to Mass to have dinner and then go over to church at 6:00 p.m. for the Stations of the Cross and other services.

Regretfully, **we have had to increase the price of single dinner tickets from \$10.00 to \$12.00**, because of substantial year-over-year increases in the cost of cod and haddock due to significant catch limits now enforced because of overfishing. An 8-oz Pacific Cod serving has increased in cost from \$2.94 to \$4.70, a 60% increase. Our 8-oz haddock serving has gone from \$3.15 last year to now \$4.35. Other menu items and ingredients have also increased in price, but less so.

Single-dinner \$12.00 adult and teen tickets are available after Mass, in the parish office, online, and at the door. **You may also purchase tickets for all six dinners in advance for \$57.00, thereby saving \$15.00. Credit cards and checks are accepted after Mass, online, and at the door.** All parishioners are welcome regardless of their ability to afford the listed price, so if you need assistance, please inquire at the parish office. Also, while we don't advertise these dinners to the general public, non-parishioners are always welcome, so bring your neighbors and friends. **Takeout is available.**

These moderate-cost dinners are part of Council 8791's ***Faith in Action*** program and are offered to help parishioners meet and socialize, fulfill their Lenten abstinence obligation, and encourage families to make **Friday Mass and the Stations of the Cross** a weekly part of their Lenten devotions. **See the other side of this letter for the dates, other details, and the link to our website <https://kofc8791.org/> to purchase tickets online.**
