## NOVEMBER APPEAL: CURRENT FUND

MISSION TO SEAFARERS: Now-Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup> donations are being accepted for the Mission to Seafarers. Each **shoe box** requires: a pair of **gloves/mitts**, **scarf**, **toque**, pair of **socks**. The items needed are those in bold type. Boxes are given to the men who come into Halifax on cargo ships. Most are not permitted off the ships and many have been working for 6-8months without seeing their families. Tues. Dec. 4, 1-2:15pm is wrapping and packing the boxes day.

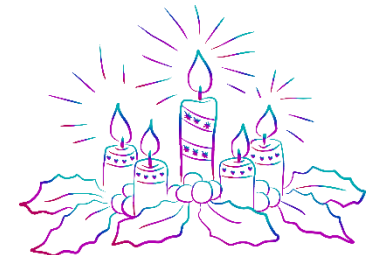
LUTHERAN WOMEN IN HRM - ADVENT LUNCH + DEVOTION
