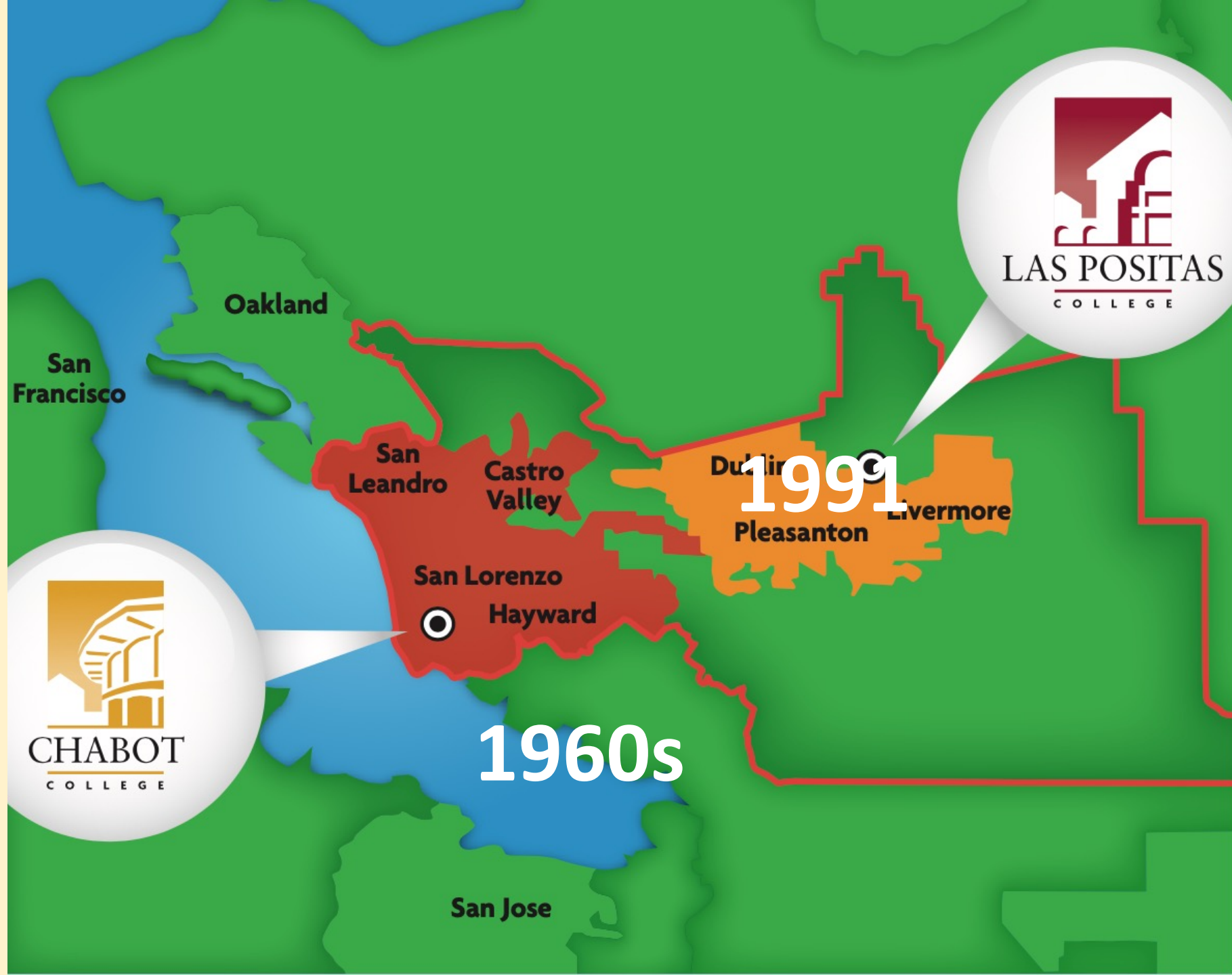

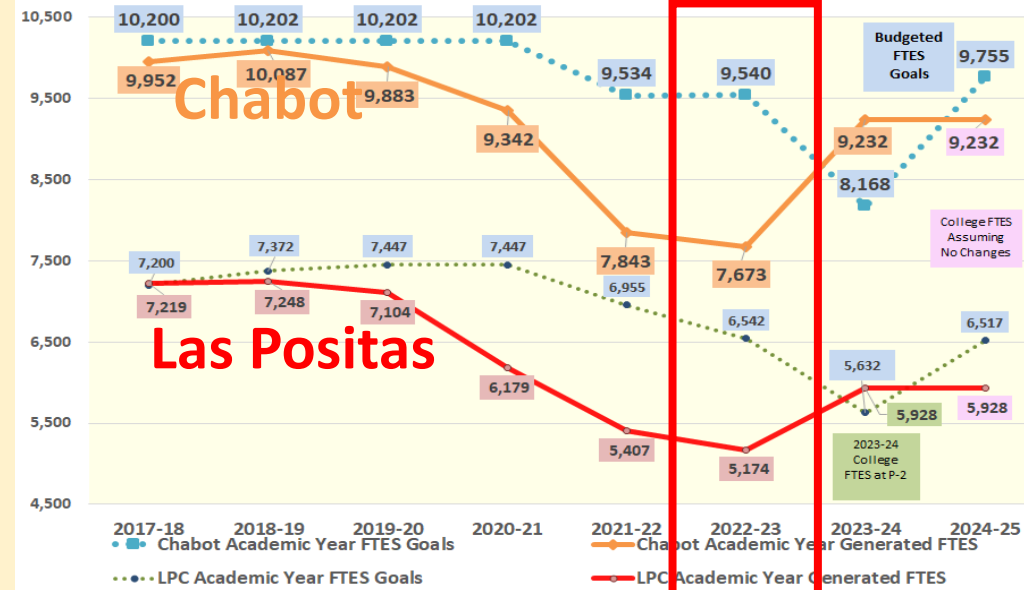

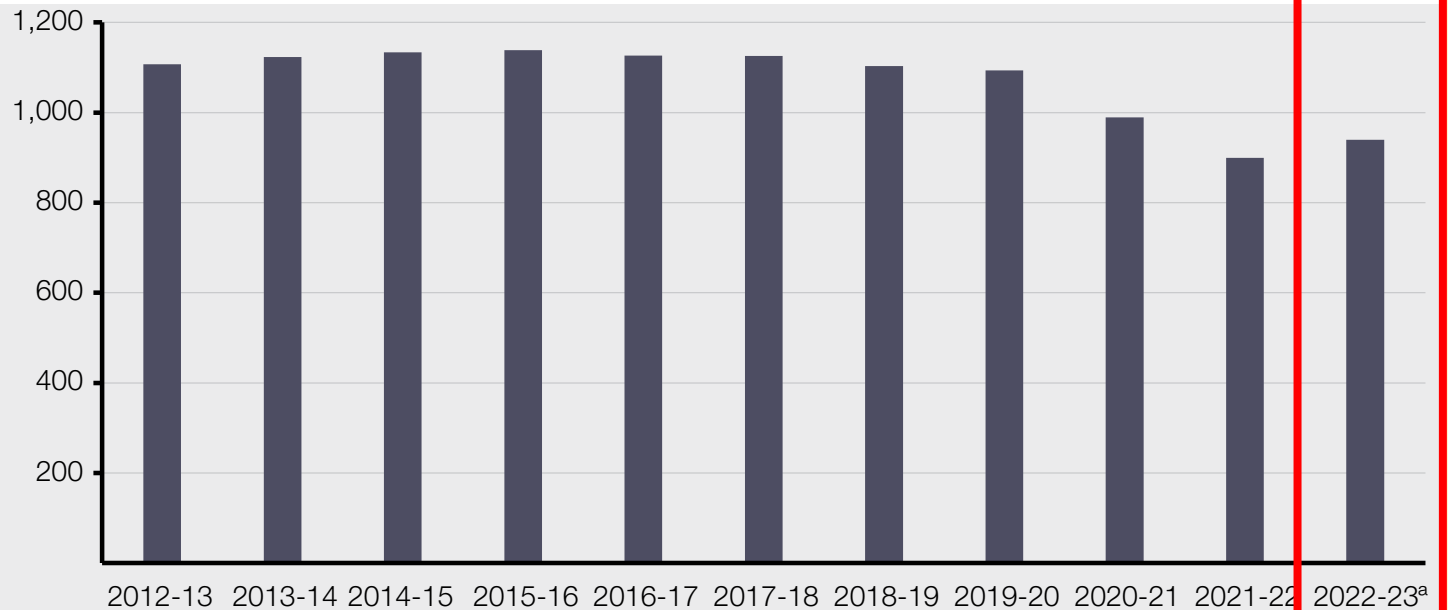
90% of revenue is from the state in the form of a fixed payment for each student.

CA CC Full-Time-Equivalent Students (1000's)

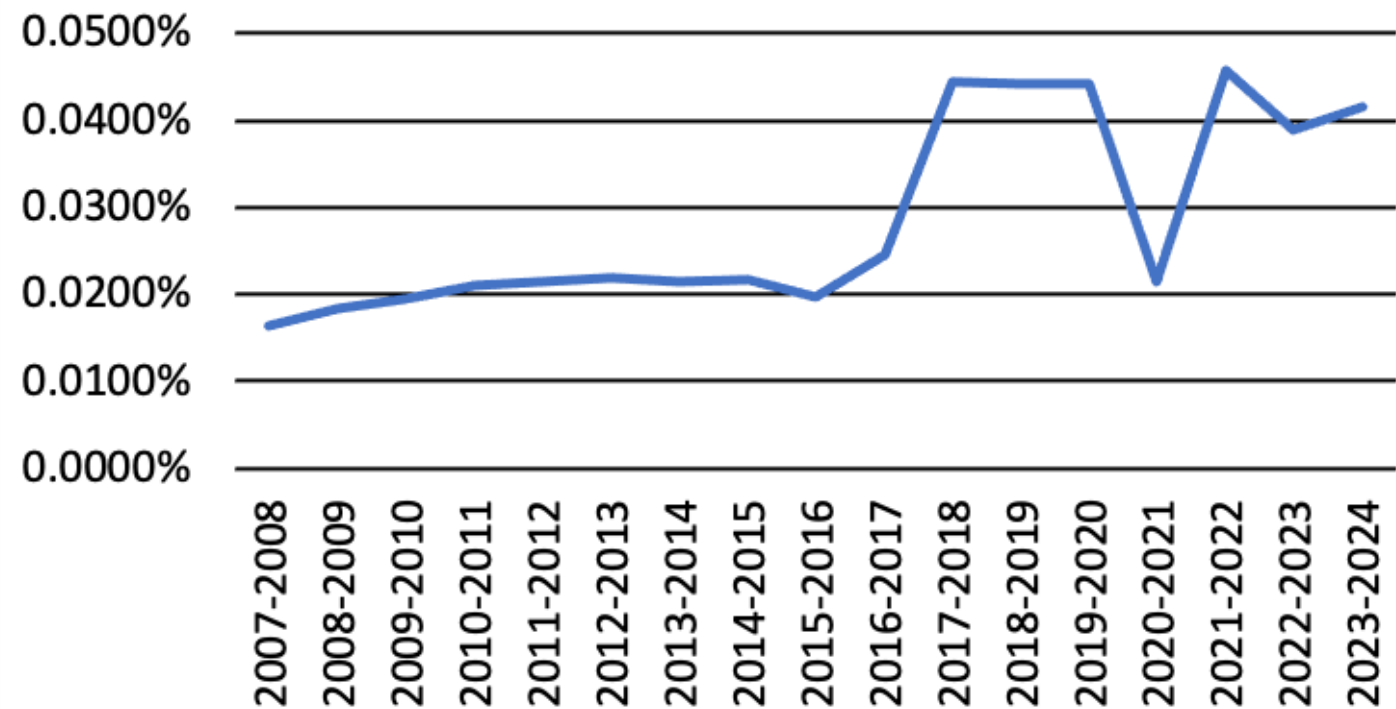


\$1 Billion in 30-year construction bonds issued over 2017-27.

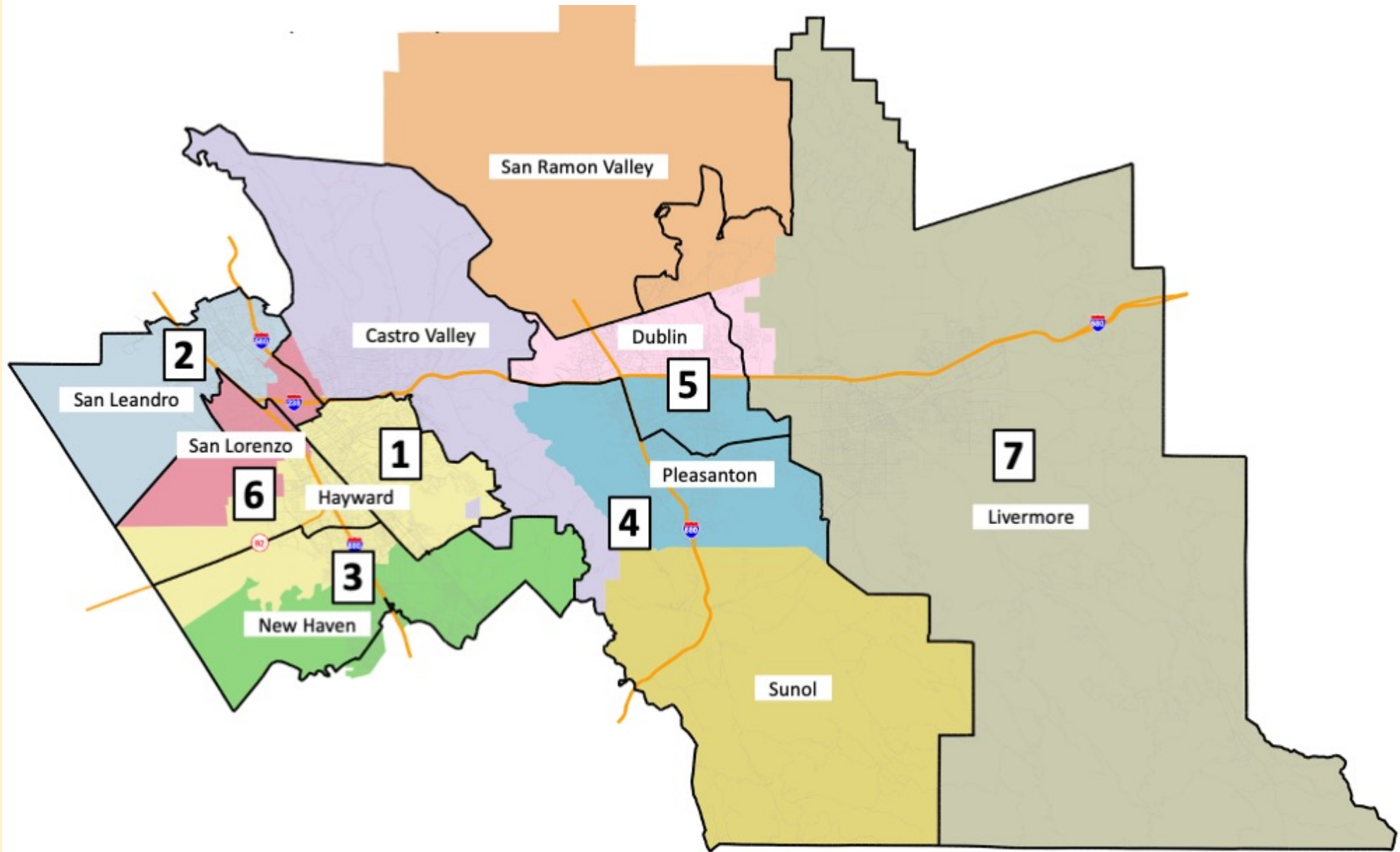

Cabot-Las Positas Property Tax Rate



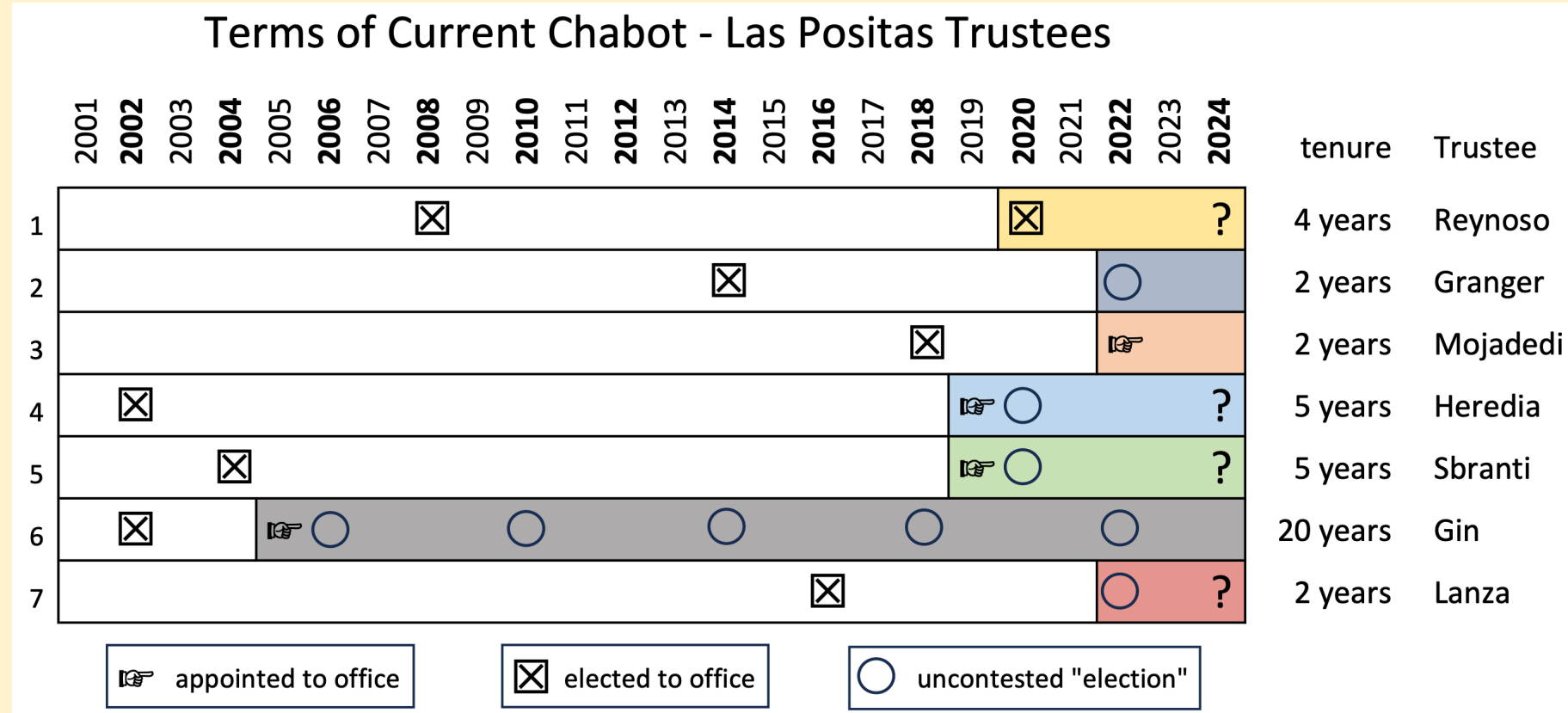
Seven Trustee Districts

Trustee Elections?

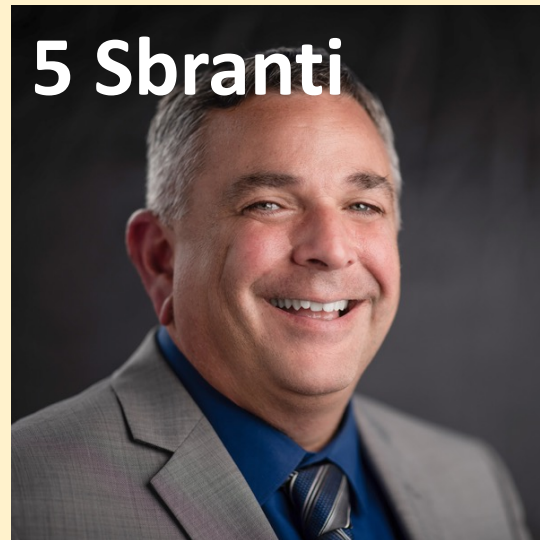
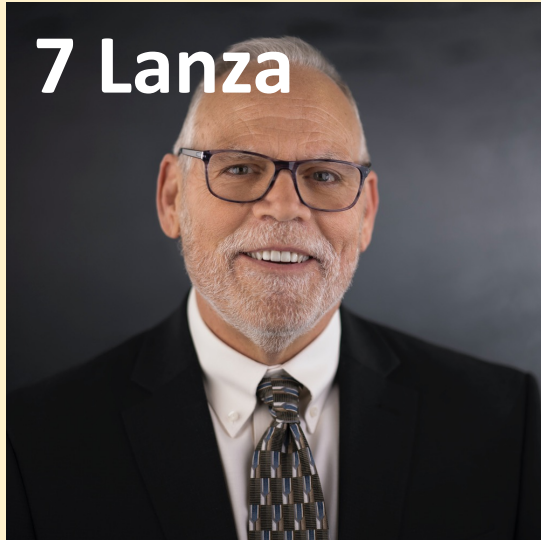
Each trustee district *should* have an election every 4 years.
